## Incident Overview

### State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) Activated to Level 2

Riverwatch 2018 began on 4/30/2018 with the SEOC standing up to a Level 2 Preparedness Level.

Kuskowkim Division is closed for Operational Period 6 due to ice and water moving freely through Bethel.

Upper Yukon Division:

Daily flights monitoring river ice status between Eagle and Circle. Ice is breaking up near Eagle and progressing downstream. Forecasted temperatures in the 60's and 70's will likely speed break-up between Eagle and Circle.

| <b>Eagle</b>                                 | <p>At 1310, the SEOC was notified by Yukon Division Supervisor Claude of a houseboat on a slough off the Yukon River with two individuals on board, near the Glenn Creek area downstream of Eagle. The boat is located between the Tatonduk River and Nation River. The situation could develop into a Search and Rescue with about fifty miles of ice heading downstream. The houseboat has been in contact with Eagle and has a radio and is reported to have a satellite phone. More information to fallow once the Yukon team flies down the river to Circle.
