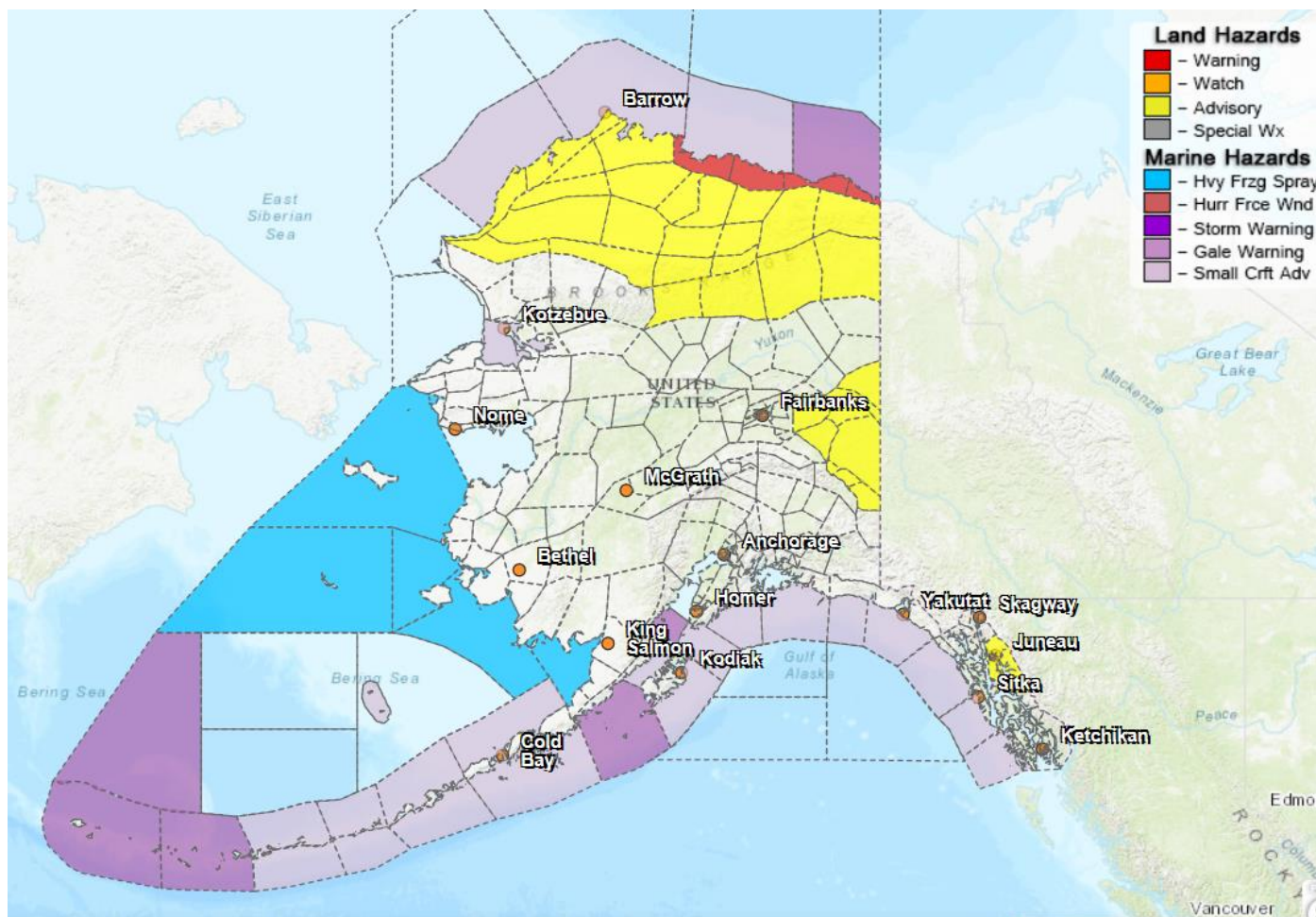

The section of the Central Beaufort Sea Coast including Nuiqsut and east to the Canadian border is under a Blizzard Warning until 9 PM AKST this evening.

Most of the northern half of the state and the Juneau area are covered by a Winter Weather Advisory.
