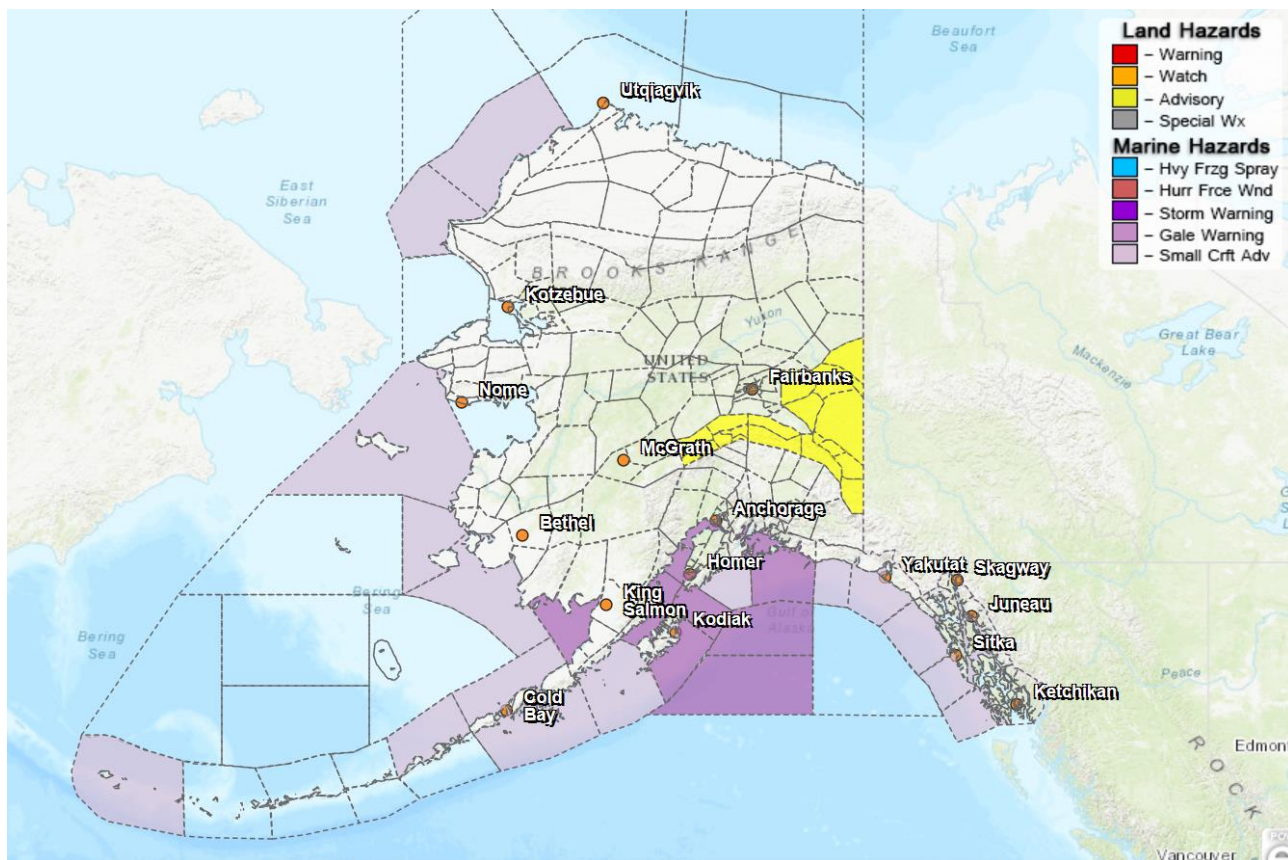

The NWS in Fairbanks has issued a Wind Advisory that remains in effect until 7 am akdt Tuesday, The Advisory stretches from Healy, Denali National Park, Carlo Creek, and Kantishna, eastward including Upper Tanana Valley, Fortymile, Tok, Tanacross, Eagle, Tetlin, Northway, Chicken, and Boundary. Forecast winds Southwest gusting up to 45 mph. The winds are expected to increase today and will peak this evening. Winds will decrease Tuesday morning.
