**Cook Inlet Earthquake:** The SEOC continues to be activated to Level 3 in response to the M7.0 earthquake affecting the Municipality of Anchorage, Matanuska-Susitna Borough, and Kenai Peninsula Borough last Friday. Joint FEMA/State/local government preliminary damage assessment teams worked in the Anchorage and Mat Su areas today.

**Diomede Power Outage:** Alaska Energy Authority reports that a utility worker with Alaska Village Electric Cooperative (AVEC) reached the village Thursday Morning and was attempting repairs.
