**Cook Inlet Earthquake (FEMA Declaration 4413-DR)**

The SEOC remains activated to Level 3. FEMA command and general staff will operate out of the SEOC until a Joint Field Office (JFO) can be set up. FEMA continues to operate a personnel mobilization center (PMC) in Anchorage to provide orientation, equipment, and other logistical support for incoming federal staff supporting the federal declaration. The Small Business Administration continues to operate a business recovery center in Eagle River and has made 150+ telephone contacts. FEMA disaster survivor assistance (DSA) teams continue to work with local government officials in all three affected jurisdictions.

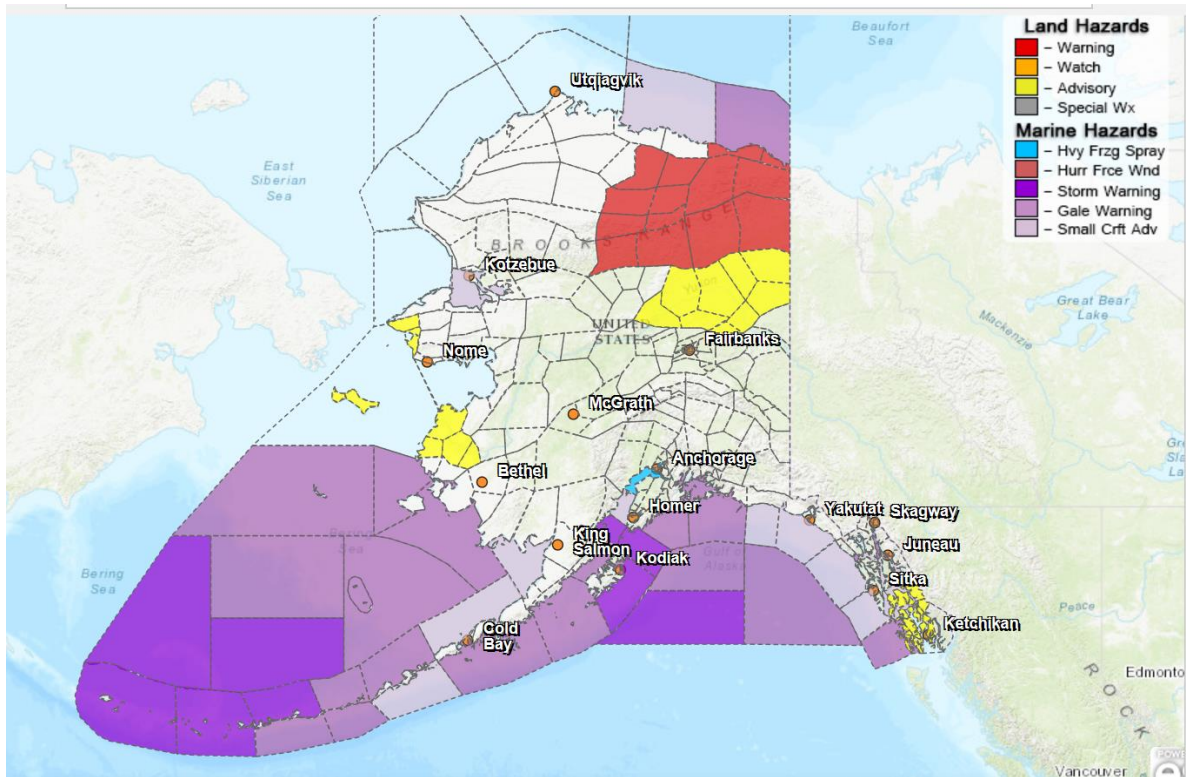
**Strong Bering Sea Storm Still Approaching**

The NWS continues to track the strong Low pressure system moving north into the Bering Sea this Wednesday. This storm is expected to track north across eastern Russia but the wind and storm effects may impact the coastal communities along the West Coast of Alaska.
