DHS&EM OPERATIONS

Cook Inlet Earthquake (FEMA Declaration 4413-DR)

The SEOC remains activated to Level 3. This is the 101st day since the earthquake. FEMA command and general staff are still working out of the SEOC; a Joint Field Office (JFO) has not yet been set up. FEMA has 249 deployed staff and four disaster recovery centers operating in Alaska in support to this disaster. The DRC in Soldotna closed last Saturday. FEMA has dispersed over \$5.5 million in Individuals & Housing Assistance and almost \$5.5 million in Housing Assistance. SBA reports they have approved 284 home loans and 13 business loans for a total of almost \$16 million.

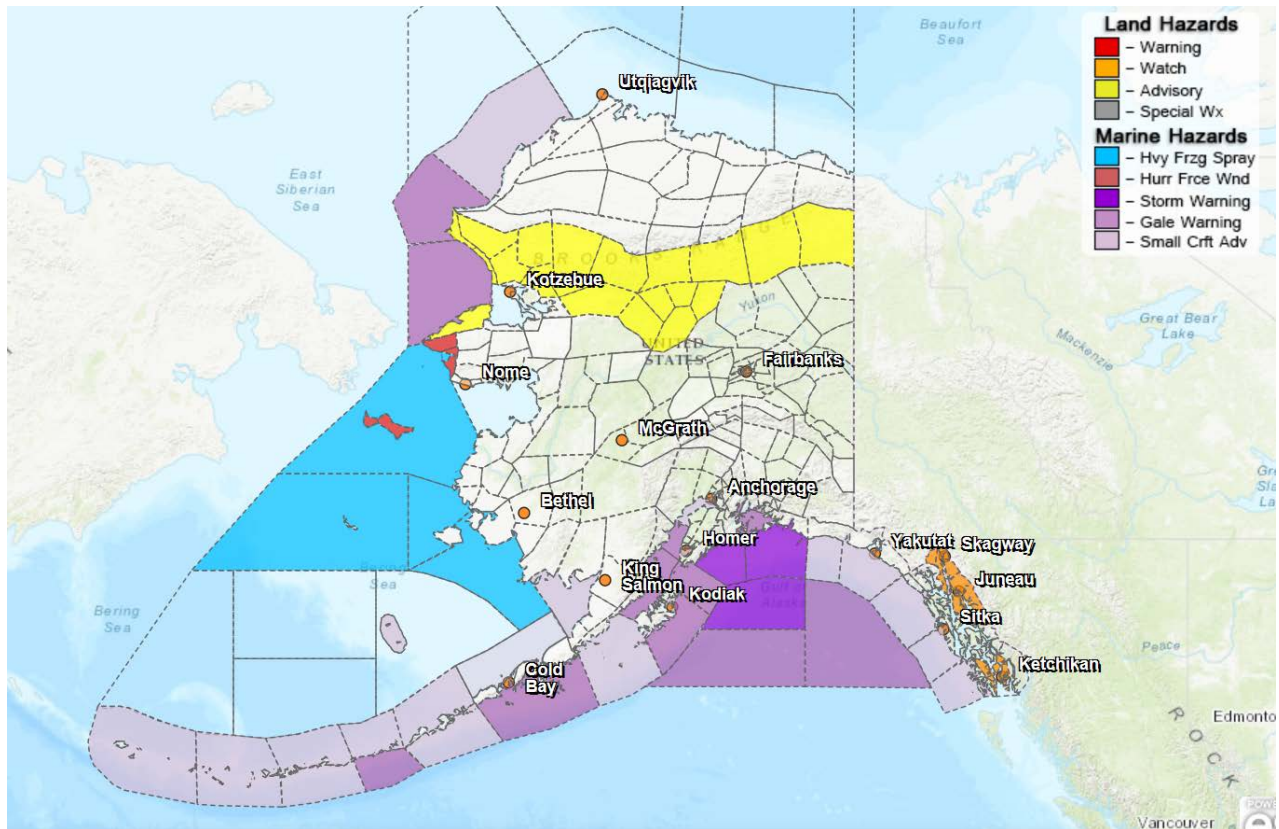
Tenakee Springs Power Outage
