

A winter weather advisory is in effect for the Yukon Delta, Lower Koyukuk and Middle Yukon Valleys, Lower Kuskokwim Valley, the Kuskokwim Delta, Copper River Basin, Yukon Flats and Surrounding Uplands, Denali, Deltana and Tanana Flats, Tanana Valley and the Fortymile County, Upper Koyukuk Valley, Middle Tanana Valley,

A winter storm warning is in effect for the Upper Kuskokwim Valley, Lower Yukon Valley, Central Interior, and the Middle Tanana Valley.

A wind advisory is in effect for the Upper Kobuk and Noatak Valleys.
