- 3/11 Governor Dunleavy declares a Public Health Disaster Emergency.
- 3/14 Governor Dunleavy announces the first confirmed case of COVID-19 in Alaska.
- 3/20 Governor Dunleavy announces Alaska COVID-19 Economic Stabilization Plan
- 3/25 First out-of-state death of an Alaska resident reported in Washington.
- 3/27 First in-state death of an Alaska resident reported in Anchorage.
- 3/28 Case count in the state exceeds 100.
- 4/7 Case count in the state exceeds 200.
- 4/9 President Trump approves a major disaster declaration for Alaska.
- 4/16 Case count in the state exceeds 300.
- 5/20 Case count in the state exceeds 400.
- 6/3 Case count in the state exceeds 500.
- 6/11 Case count in the state exceeds 600.
- 6/18 Case count in the state exceeds 700.
- 6/25 Case count in the state exceeds 800.
- 6/29 Case count in the state exceeds 900.
- 7/2 Case count in the state exceeds 1000.
- 7/4 Case count in the state exceeds 1100.

### Interior

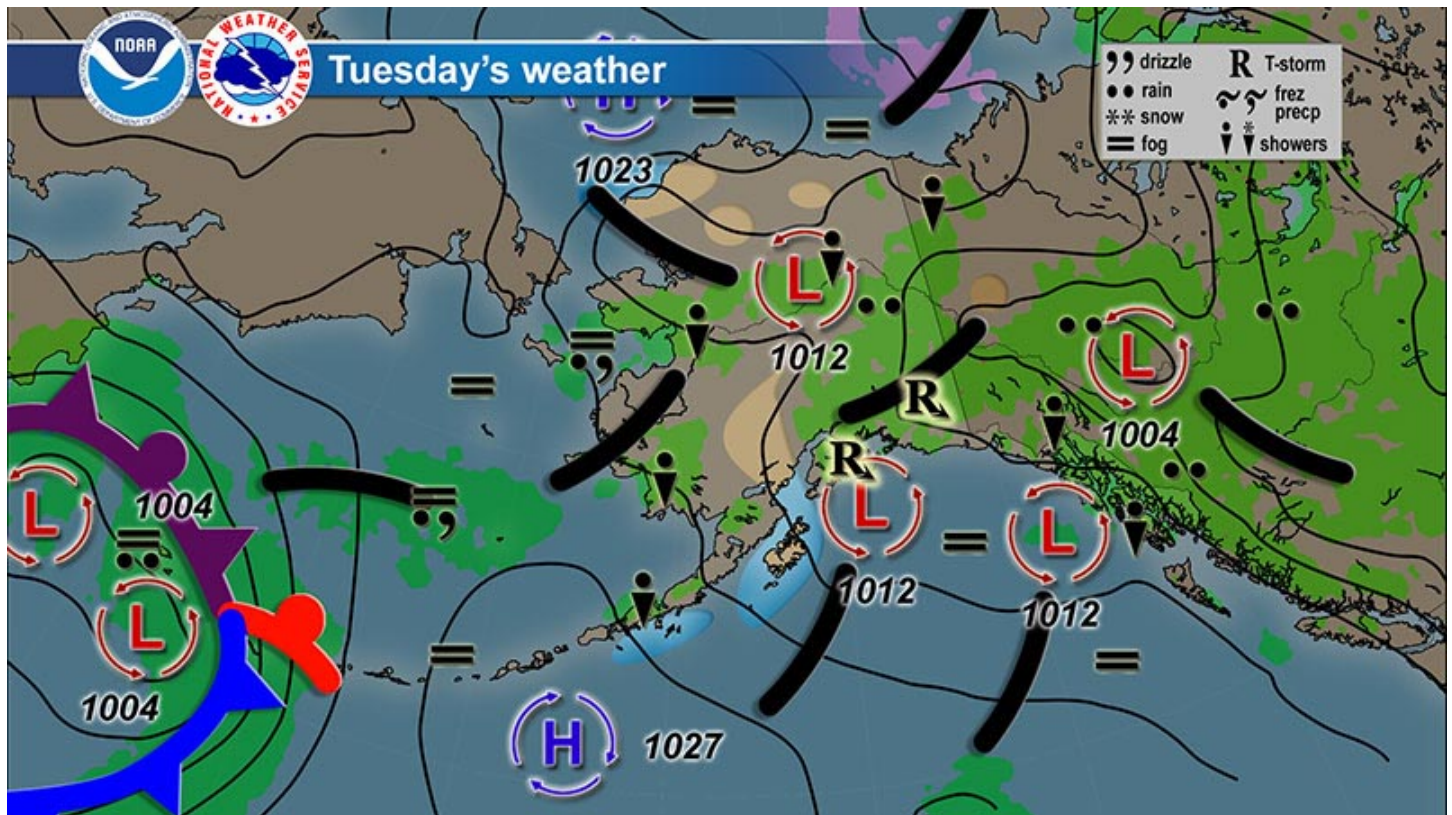
- Afternoon wet thunderstorms Monday and Eastern Interior Tuesday
