

Winter Weather Advisories have been Issued for Southeastern Brooks Range, St. Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast, Central Beaufort Sea Coast and Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast.

Wind Chill Advisories remain in effect through this afternoon and evening for Denali, Upper Tanana Valley and the Fortymile Country, Eastern Alaska Range, Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Chukchi Sea Coast, Upper and Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys, and Northern and Interior Seward Peninsula. with a Wind Chill Warning issued for Northeastern Brooks Range through 6:00 pm this evening.

A Flood Advisory has been issued for the Southern Inner Channels.
