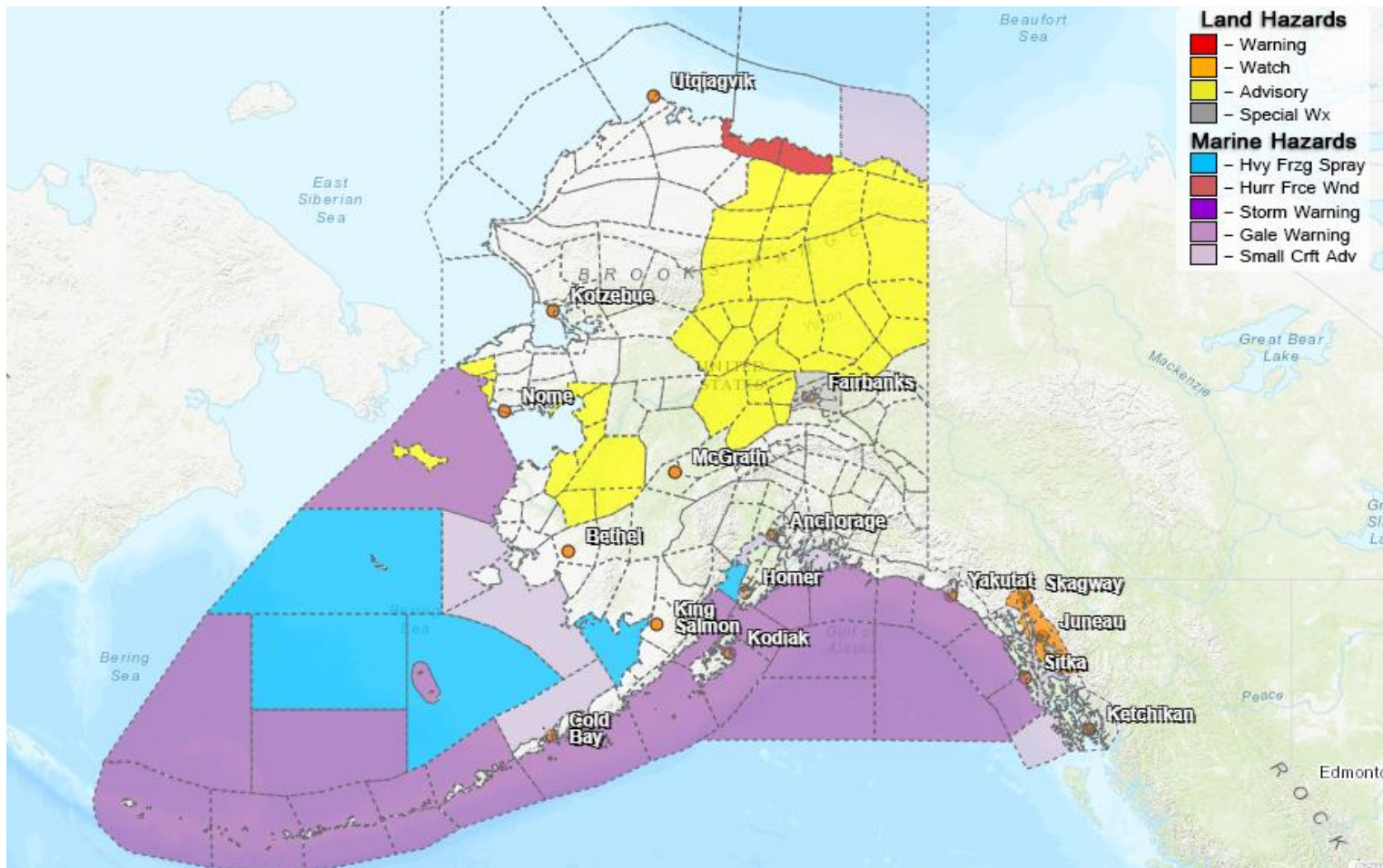

Winter Storm Watch in effect through Wednesday evening from north of Haines to south of Juneau.

Wind Chill Warning in effect until 6:00am Wednesday for the central Beaufort Sea Coast.

Wind Chill Advisory in effect until 6:00pm Wednesday evening for portions of the Lower Yukon Valley, St. Lawrence Island, Bering Strait Coast, and Eastern Norton Sound.

Wind Chill advisories in effect until midnight Thursday for the Brooks Range, Upper Koyukuk and surrounding areas.
