DHSS is closely monitoring the rapidly-emerging outbreak of novel coronavirus (COVID-19).



High wind warnings in effect for Yakutat and Juneau until 6:00pm Thursday evening.

Wind advisory in effect from Denali Park to the Eastern Alaska Range until 6:00pm Thursday.

Wind chill and winter weather advisories in effect for the Yukon Delta, Kuskokwim Delta, Eastern Norton Sound, central and eastern Seward Peninsula until Friday morning.

Winter weather advisory in effect for the Chukchi Sea Coast, St. Lawrence Island and Bering Strait until midnight Thursday.

# **Avalanche Hazards**

**Cordova:** Avalanche Hazard is high above 2,000 feet, considerable below 2,000 feet, Moderate below 1,000 feet.

Valdez: Avalanche Hazard is high at all elevations.

Turnagain Pass: Avalanche Hazard is high at all elevations.

**Hatcher Pass:** Avalanche Hazard is considerable below 2,500 feet, and high hazard above 2,500 feet.
