Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC Preparedness Level remains at Level 3 for this event.

2020 Fire Season

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center, (AICC) is at **Preparedness Level 2 (Down from 3)**.

Wildland fire totals for 2020:

Total Fires = **267**
Total Acres = **170,575**

There are currently **103** active fires with **5** fires currently staffed.

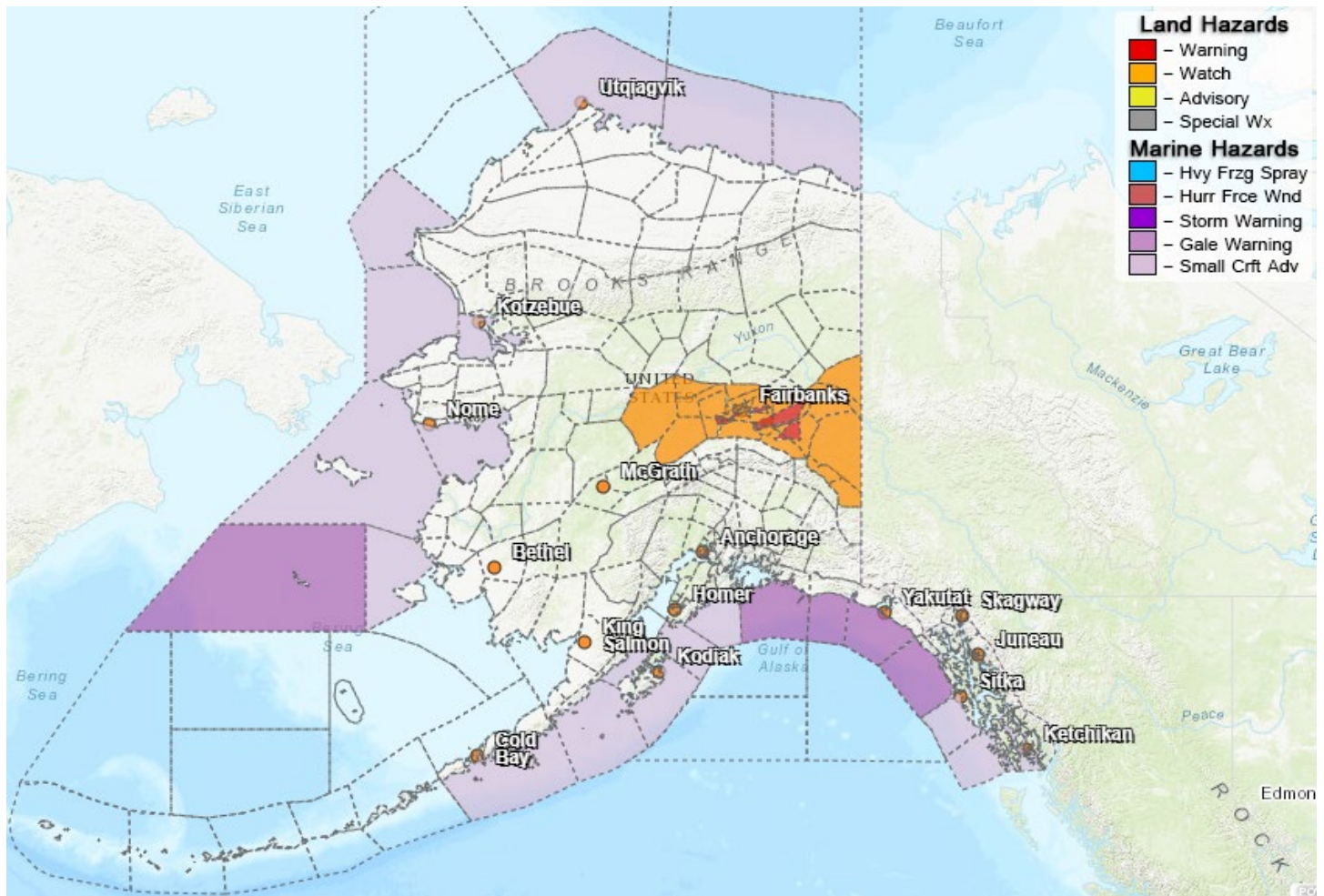

Flood warnings are in effect for the following areas:

- Tanana River in Nenana – in effect until 12:15 Saturday
- Chena River upstream of the Moose Creek Dam – in effect until 7:45 AM Friday
- Goodpaster River – in effect until 11 PM Saturday
- Tanana River in Fairbanks in the Rosie Creek Area – in effect until 9 AM Friday
- Salcha River in Salcha – in effect until 8:30 PM Thursday

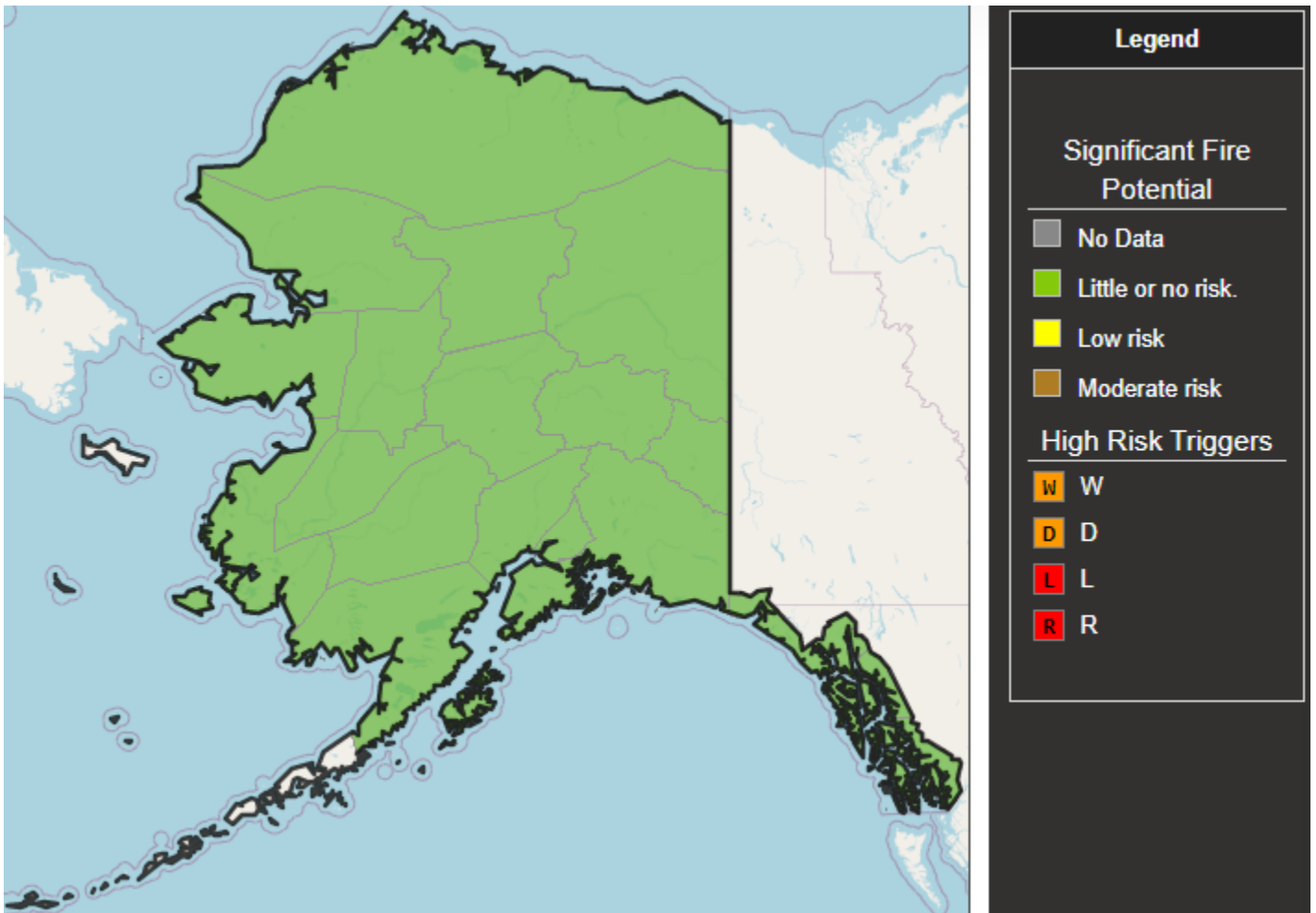
Flood watches are in effect for the following areas:

- Tanana River – in effect through Friday afternoon
- Mainstem rivers in the Middle Tanana Valley – in effect until Friday afternoon
- Mainstem Rivers in the Deltana and Tanana Flats from the Little Delta River east – in effect until Friday afternoon
- Mainstem Rivers in the Upper Tanana Valley including the Tanana River – in effect until Friday afternoon
