### **Significant Issues**

#### **Chignik 7.8 Earthquake**

Alaska DOT&PF engineers performed an earthquake damage assessment of several AMHS ports-of-call and State bridges that were located within a 200-mile radius of the M7.8 earthquake that occurred on July 21, 2020 – roughly 60 miles south-southeast of Perryville. The purpose of this inspection trip was to quantify damages to essential regional infrastructure. The inspection team visited docks, bridges, and other facilities in Akutan, Cold Bay, Chignik, False Pass, King Cove, Perryville, and Sand Point. The Lake and Peninsula Borough is following up with impacted communities this week.

#### **Delta River Flooding**

DOT&PF has completed preliminary repairs that have stopped the active flooding. An inspector with the Natural Resources Conservation Service will be conducting an assessment of the Spengler Road/Delta River site on Wednesday morning to determine eligibility for the NRCS Emergency Watershed Protection Program. The SEOC continues to coordinate with DOT&PF and our federal agency partners to develop a plan for a long-term solution.

#### **Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic**

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC Preparedness Level remains at Level 3 for this event.

## **2020 Fire Season**

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center, (AICC) is at Preparedness Level 1.

Total Acres = **181,677**

There are currently **20** active fires with 0 fires currently staffed.

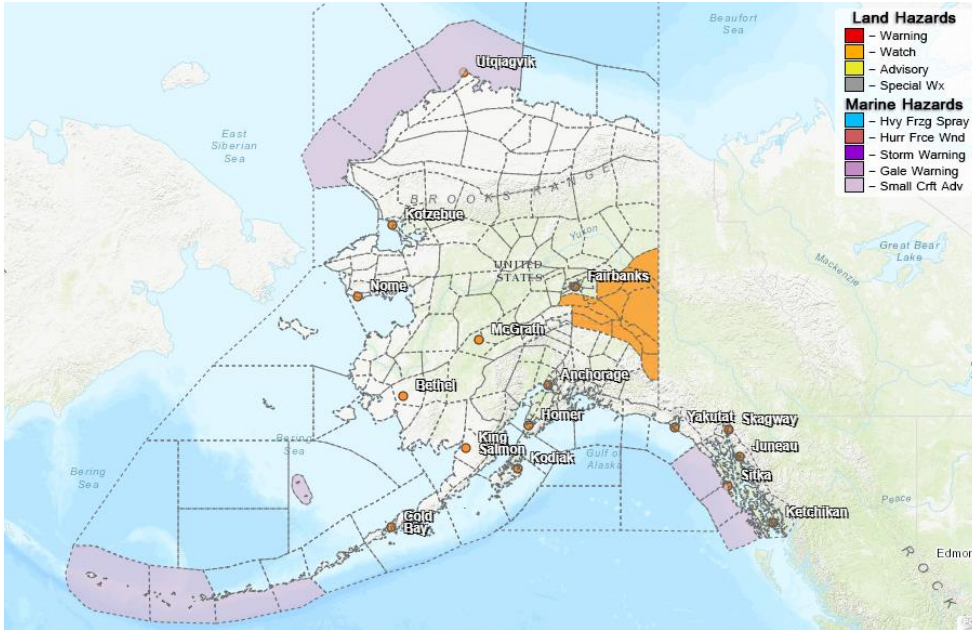

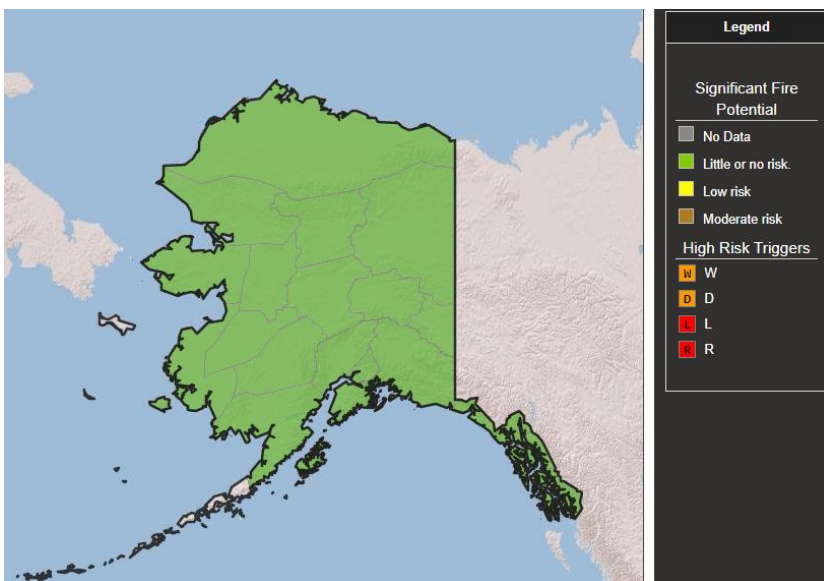
## Significant Weather:
