

#### **Significant Weather:**



A Wind Advisory has been issued for the Lower Yukon Valley. Southeast winds of 20mph to 30mph with gusts to 45mph are expected until 10:00 P.M. today (10/07)

A High Surf Advisory has been issued for the Kuskokwim Delta from Goodnews Bay to Hooper Bay until 10:00 A.M. today. 45mph winds and surf levels of up to 3 feet above normal are expected in the area.

A Special Weather Statement has been issued for St. Lawrence Island and the western coast of Alaska. A strong storm is expected to move into the area Tuesday (10/06) evening into Wednesday (10/07) Forecasted winds of 65mph and elevated surf 1 to 3 feet above normal are expected for the area.
