#### **Tuluksak Washeteria Fire:**

The SEOC continues to be in contact with the community of Tuluksak as well as multiple state, federal, and tribal organizations in support of both the short and long-term recovery efforts for the community. Construction work on a temporary non-potable water supply system in the community will begin this week.



#### Significant Weather:



Winter Weather Advisories are in effect for the Brooks Range, Koyukuk Valley, Yukon Flats, Central Interior, Tanana Valley, St. Lawrence Island, and the Bering Strait Coast until midnight on Tuesday.

Wind Chill Warnings, Watches, & Advisories are in effect for most of the Central and Northern Interior as well as portions of the Alaska Panhandle through noon on Wednesday.

A Special Weather Statement has been issued for the Alaska Panhandle. Low temperatures Tuesday and Wednesday are expected to be near or below zero for northern Lynn Canal and in the single digits from Gustavus to Juneau. Temperatures are expected to begin to moderate by the end of the week.
