## August 2021 Alaska Peninsula M6.9 Earthquake:

Just before 4:00 A.M. on Saturday, August 14<sup>th</sup> a M6.9 EQ occurred 85 miles southeast of Perryville AK. The earthquake was felt as far away as Kodiak and Bethel. The SEOC has been in contact with communities near the epicenter to assess any impacts it may have caused. There have been no reports of any damages or injuries at this time.



# Significant Weather:



A Special Weather Statement is in effect for the Northern Brooks Range. Additional snowfall is expected over the next two days. Accumulations of up to four inches are possible.

A Special Weather Statement has been issued for the Central Interior. An additional one to two inches of rainfall is possible across the region causing an increase in water levels in streams and rivers and increasing the risk for landslides due to the already saturated ground.
