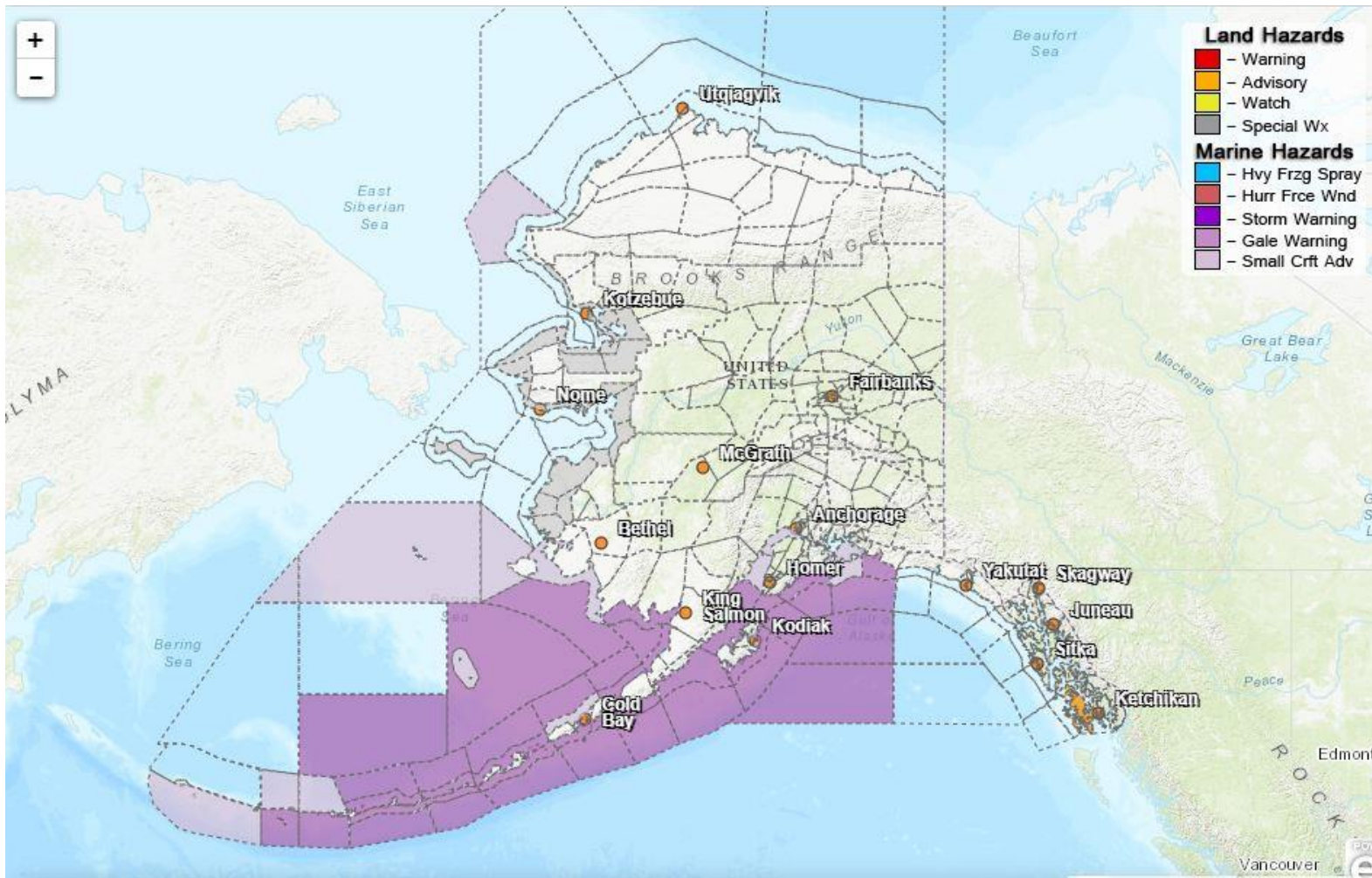

**Special Weather Statement:**

Prince of Wales Island: Dense Fog Advisory issued September 29 at 1:06AM AKDT until September 29 at 10:00AM AKDT by NWS Juneau AK If driving, slow down, use your low-beam headlights, & leave plenty of distance between you & the vehicle ahead of you.

Elevated surf is expected to develop along the West Coast Saturday night and continue into Sunday. Northerly winds of 20 to 30 mph with gusts to 40 mph will cause elevated surf for north facing coastal areas for Kivalina and Red Dog Dock; Lower Kobuk Valley; Baldwin Peninsula; Northern Seward Peninsula; Shishmaref; Bering Strait Coast; Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; Yukon Delta Coast; St Lawrence Island.
