# Significant Issues:

#### **Wrangell Landside Disaster:**

The deadline to apply for State Individual Assistance is January 27, 2024.

#### **Selawik Power Outage:**

SEOC actively monitoring events and remains in close contact. 39 homes remain without water/sewer, and 8 homes remain without heat. The SEOC and the North Slope borough continue to work with the community to address needs.

# **Point Hope Power Outage:**

SEOC is actively monitoring Point Hope's multiagency response. Community officials continue to coordinate with the North Slope Borough for assistance and documenting what homes still need to be thawed.

# **Manokotak Power Outage:**

SEOC held a mass care meeting with the community to identify any feeding or sheltering needs, none were identified. The school generator remains operational, and the school can be used as a shelter/showering location if necessary.

#### Savoonga Power Outage:

Community reports all power has been restored. A local damage assessment in ongoing for possible loss of food and any other mass care needs.




#### **Avalanche Hazards:**
