Severed Offshore Internet Cable - Utgiagvik

SEOC continues to participate in regular inter-agency coordination calla with the North Slope Borough, North Slope School District, regional tribal organizations, and communications agencies.

The Borough extended their local declaration of disaster emergency for this incident until September 1, 2023.

2023 Spring Floods Disaster

The Disaster Assistance Centers Fort Yukon and Kwethluk have completed Individual assistance registrations and inspections and Public Assistance damage reviews in preparation for the joint Preliminary Damage Assessments with the Federal Emergency Management Agency slated for mid-July and have demobilized. The Disaster Assistance Center in Russian Mission will complete its tasks and demobilize today.

To date the state has received over 200 total disaster Individual Assistance registrations. Deadline for Registration has been extended to July 23, 2023.


