### **Significant Issues:**

#### **2023 Spring Floods Disaster**

A joint team from the SEOC, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Small Business Administration (SBA) are traveling to Glenallen today to begin Joint Preliminary Damage assessments for potential federal assistance. Additional teams will be deployed later this week to the communities of Circle, Fort Yukon, and Stevens Village.

Deadline for Individual and Public Assistance Registration has been extended to July 23, 2023.

## Alaska Wildland 2023 Fire Season:

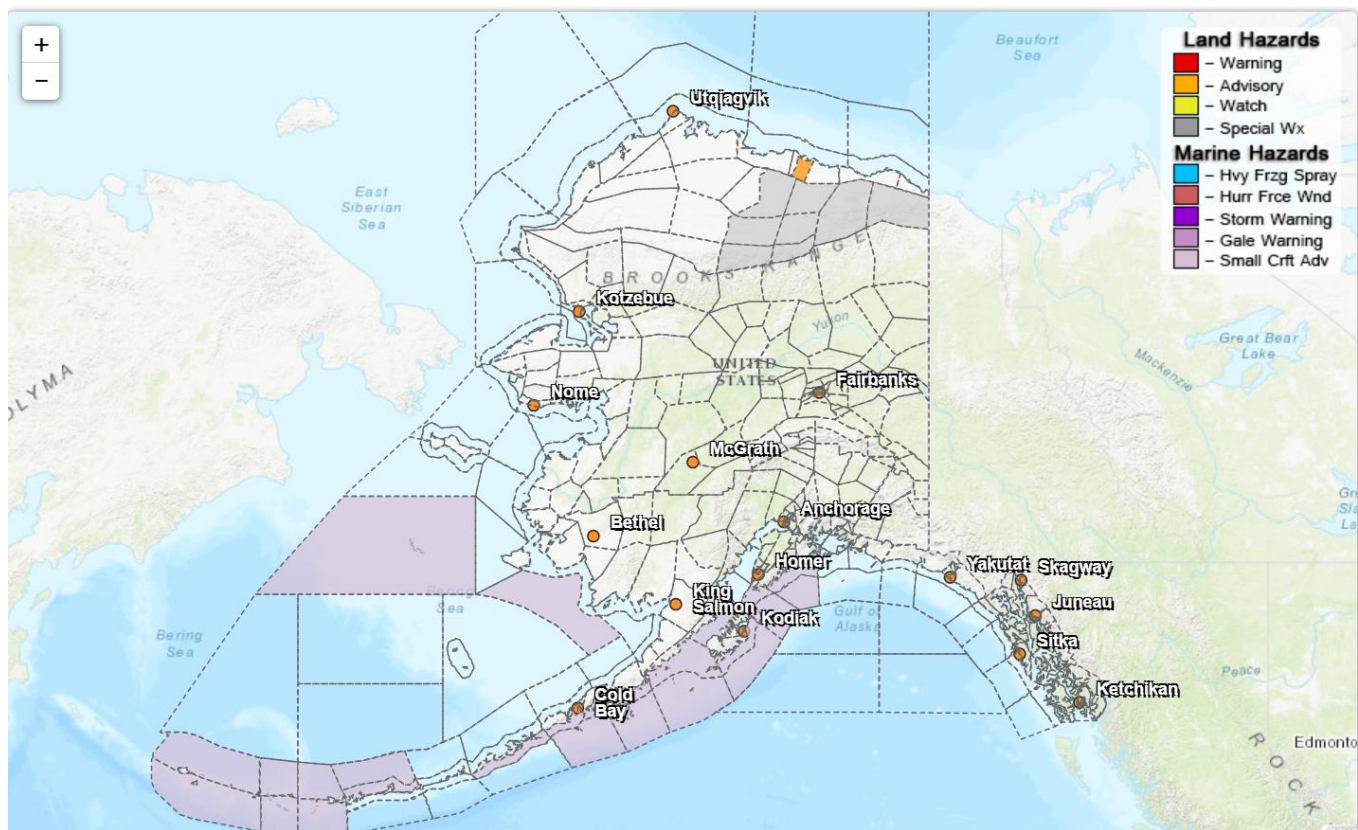
