#### Significant Issues:

#### Juneau Suicide Basin Flooding:

SEOC will deploy personnel to open a Disaster Assistance Center (DAC) in Juneau on Monday. This center will open at the Mendenhall Valley Library on Monday at noon and operate Tuesday and Wednesday to provide in-person registration for state disaster Individual Assistance, meetings with volunteer response agencies, officials from the City and Borough of Juneau.

SEOC has approved a State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities aerial mapping mission over the flood damage that will fly as soon as weather permits.

Wednesday SEOC will deploy a joint Preliminary Damage Assessment team with the Federal Emergency Management Agency to develop specific damage information required to support consideration of a request for federal assistance.

#### **Statewide Wildland Fire Situation:**

Wildland fire activity is on the decline. There are currently 9 staffed fires with over 1,000 fire personnel actively engaged in fire suppression and mop-up across the State.

The Mobile Emergency Operations Center deployed to the Anderson Fire Complex will demobilize today. The Alaska National Guard Armory in Fairbanks continues to support fire crew mobilization.


The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center is at Preparedness Level 3
