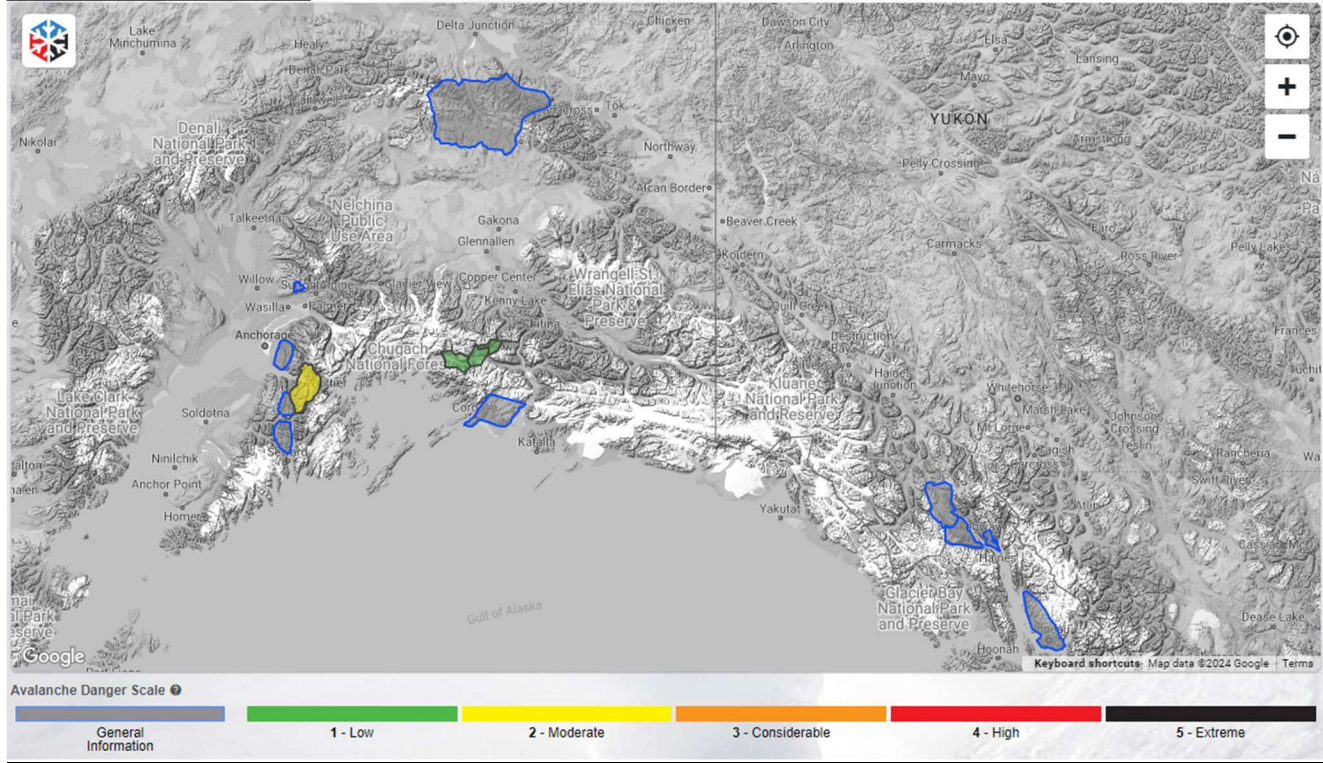

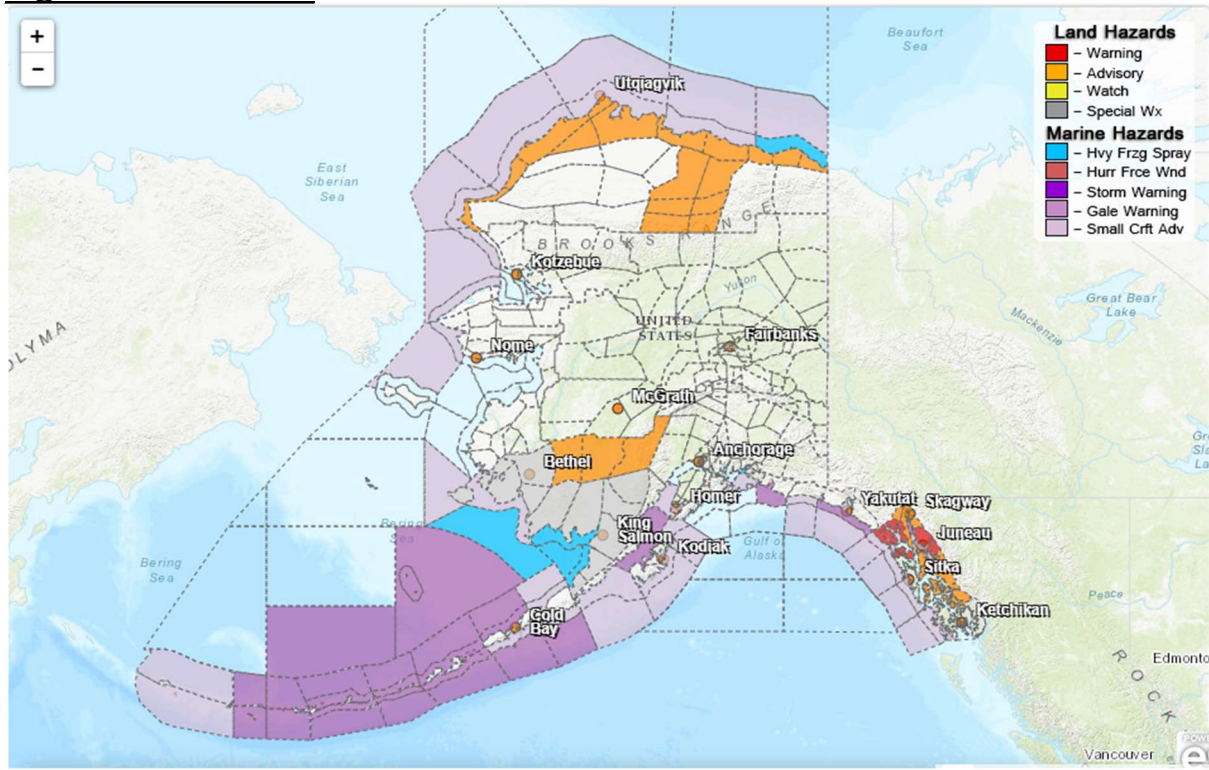
Avalanche Hazards:



- Turnagain Pass –Moderate above 1,000 FT and below 1,000 ft will remain and low.
- Valdez – Low at all altitudes

Wind Chill Advisory

- **Lower Kuskokwim Valley** – in effect until 7 PM AKST tonight, temperatures as low as -45' expected.

Special Weather Statement

- **Kuskokwim Delta and Bristol Bay** – Cold wind chills (as low as -35' F) expected through tonight.

Winter Storm Warning –

- **Glacier Bay; Eastern Chichagof Island; Cape Fairweather to Lisianski Strait and the City and Borough of Juneau** - Heavy snow and freezing rain. Additional snow accumulations of 6 to 12 inches, with 10 to 16 inches for Gustavus and Juneau and ice accumulations from freezing rain of up to two tenths of an inch. Warning in effect until 9 AM AKST Tuesday morning.

Winter Weather Advisory

- **Petersburg Borough, and the City and Borough of Wrangell** – in effect until Noon AKST today.
- **Admiralty Island; Western Kupreanof and Kuiu Island** – in effect until 3 PM AKST this afternoon.
- **Municipality of Skagway; Haines Borough and Klukwan; Western Arctic Coast; Northwest Arctic Coast and Northern Arctic Coast** – in effect until from 9 AM this morning to 6 AM AKST Tuesday.
- **Central Arctic Plains and Central Brook Range** – in effect from 6 PM this evening to 6 AM AKST Wednesday.
- **Central Beaufort Sea Coast and Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast** – in effect from 6 PM this evening to Noon AKST Wednesday.
