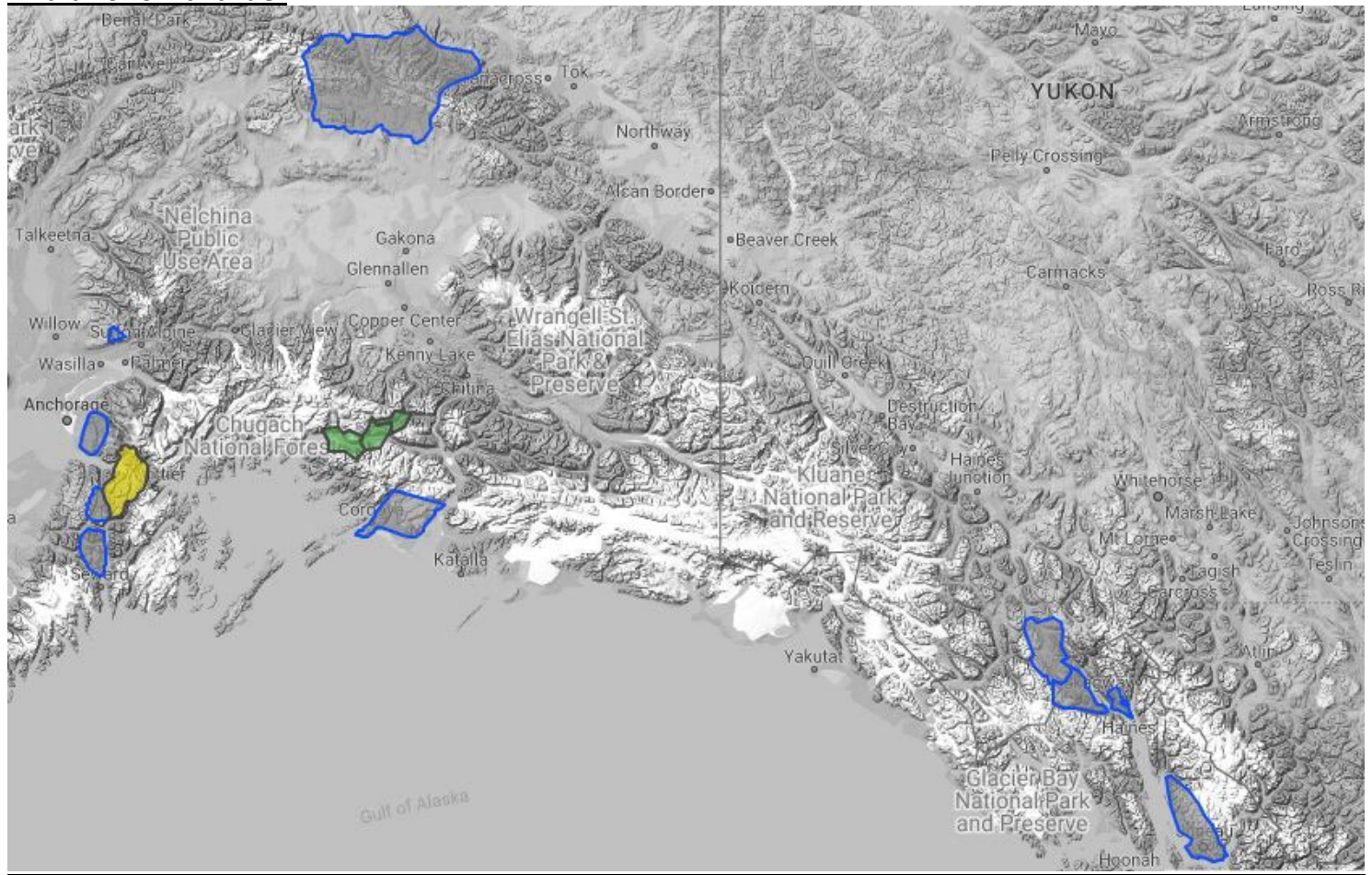

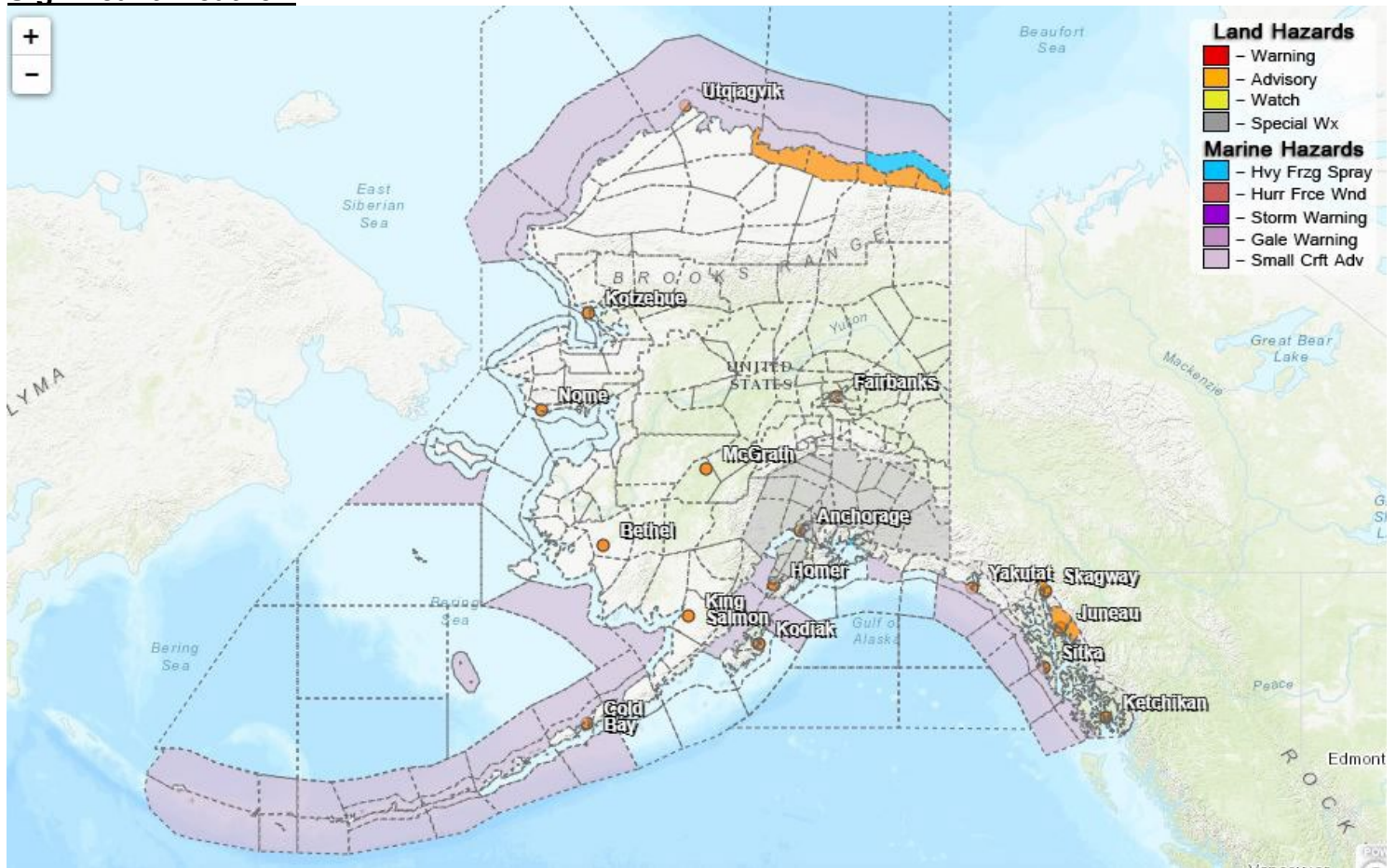
## Avalanche Hazards:
