

River Watch and Spring Breakup: The SEOC continues to monitor breakup along the Yukon River. The Middle Yukon from Nulato upstream to Rampart Canyon is mostly clear with light ice runs still flowing downstream. No significant changes along the Yukon River.

The SEOC is in communication with the Alaska Railroad monitoring the condition of the section of railroad tracks damaged due to an ice jam on the Susitna River.
