#### Significant Issues:

The SEOC is monitoring a storm related power outage in Diomede. The SEOC has been in contact with the community, assisting agencies and the local government specialist. Repairs are expected as soon as Sunday afternoon. No injuries or other reports of damage were reported and there are no requests for additional State assistance at this time. SEOC will continue to monitor the situation and maintain regular contact with the community.



A Special Weather Statement for Heavy Rain with High River Levels has been issued for the coastal areas of Cape Decision to Salisbury Sound, Cape Fairweather to Cape Suckling, Dixon Entrance to Cape Decision, and for Eastern Baranof, Southern Admiralty, and Eastern Chichagof Islands, for Glacer Bay, Inner Channels from Kupreanof Island to Etolin Island, Juneau Borough and Northern Admiralty Island, Salisbury Sound to Cape Fairweather Coastal Area and Southern Inner Channels through 1600 this afternoon.

Winter Weather Advisory is in effect until noon today for snow and freezing rain in the Upper Kuskokwim Valley.

A Special Weather Statement has been issued for St Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast through Saturday night for Strong Winds gusting to 55 mph and Heavy Freezing Spray and High Surf.

A High Surf Advisory is in effect until 1800 Saturday for the North Coast of St Lawrence Island.

A Winter Storm Warning is in effect 1600 today for Taiya Inlet and the South Klondike Highway for heavy snow with accumulations of 6 to 9 inches expected.

A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect until midnight AKST tonight north of Talkeetna for snow accumulations of 8 to 12 inches.
