North Pole: Stage 2 Alert: All solid fuel-fired devices must cease operation unless the exceptions above apply. Residents should rely instead on their home's cleaner source of heat (such as a gas or fuel oil fired furnace or boiler or electric baseboard heaters) until the Stage 2 alert is canceled.


If you have a NOASH waiver, these alerts do not apply to you.
