THREAT LEVEL CHANGES: SEOC LEVEL 1 – ROUTINE OPERATIONS

NTAS BULLETIN: On January 4, 2020, Acting Secretary of Homeland Security Chad F. Wolf issued a new National Terrorism Advisory System (NTAS) Bulletin pertaining to the changing threat landscape following the successful U.S.-led airstrike in Iraq that eliminated Qaseem Soleimani, the head of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps-Quds Force, a U.S.-designated Foreign Terrorist Organization.

<u>Significant Issues:</u> The Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) Rural Utility Management Services has been working to resolve frozen water and wastewater service in the communities of St. Michael, Noatak, and Selawik. So far, the issue in Noatak has been resolved, and the SEOC has no additional assistance requests from the two remaining communities at this time. The SEOC will closely monitor these restoration efforts over the weekend.

The SEOC continues to monitor the response and recovery efforts underway for the flooding along Willow Creek in the Matanuska Susitna Borough (MSB).


