A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC Preparedness Level remains at Level 3 for this event.

#### 2020 Fire Season

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center, (AICC) is at Preparedness Level 3.

Wildland fire totals for 2020:

Total Fires = 263

Total Acres = 164,510

There are currently 105 active fires with 6 fires currently staffed.



A flood warning is in effect for the entire Goodpastor River until 11 pm Wednesday. This will be the highest flood level on record for this drainage system.


Flood watches for streams and rivers are in effect through Wednesday evening for the following areas:
