## Significant Issues

## Chignik 7.8 Earthquake

The SEOC continues to compile damages from the M7.8 earthquake last month. DOT&PF engineers conducted a damage assessment of the "new" City of Sand Point dock on July 25. This structure is a city-owned, state-used (Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS) port of call) facility located approximately 82 miles from the earthquake epicenter. The purpose of this assessment was to identify any resulting critical damage that would restrict the public's use of the dock as part of the state's AMHS operations. Signs of significant earthquake related movements of the dock and approach embankment were observed; however, no critical damage was found that would limit or reduce continued state / AMHS use at this time. At the request of the City, the Old Sand Point dock was given a courtesy visual inspection. There are signs of significant earthquake related movements of the dock and approach embankment were identified and structural damage was observed.

## **Delta River Flooding**

DOT&PF continues to develop plans to address the flooding of Spengler Road, near Delta. Water levels on the Delta River remain high. An inspector for the Natural Resources Conservation Service is expected to visit the area this week to evaluate the repairs for possible federal funding under their Emergency Watershed Protection program.

## Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC Preparedness Level remains at Level 3 for this event

## 2020 Fire Season

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center, (AICC) is at Preparedness Level 1.

There are currently 26 active fires with 0 fires currently staffed.


