Significant Issues

Selawik Fire:

Over the weekend, the local store in Selawik was destroyed by fire. The SEOC coordinated an interagency teleconference call with the community and the Northwest Arctic Borough to gather additional information. There does not appear to be any immediate needs, but the SEOC will work with the community, borough, and the mass care task force to determine what assistance can be provided.

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic:

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC continues to support statewide response to COVID-19.


Air Quality Index (AQI) Advisories

Significant Weather:



A Winter Storm Warning is in effect until 12:00 P.M. Saturday for the Upper Koyukuk Valley, Central Interior, Southeast Brooks Range, Yukon Flats and Surrounding Uplands and the Middle Tanana Valley. Heavy snow expected. Travel will be difficult. Blowing snow in higher elevations. Total snow accumulations of 8 inches are expected. Chance of freezing rain.

A High Wind Watch is in effect until 3:00 pm this afternoon for Yukon Delta. South winds of 35 to 45mph with gusts to 65mph are possible for the area.

A Windter Storm Warning remains in effect until noon today for St Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast and unitl 11:00 pm for Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills. Expect blowing snow with total snow accumulations of 3 to 5 inches.

A Winter Storm Warning is in effect from 4:55 am this morning 6:00 pm Friday for Chukchi Sea Coast, Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys, Baldwin Peninsula and Selawik Valley with total snow accumulations of 6-10 inches.

A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect from 4:55 am this morning 6:00 pm Friday for Kuskokwim Valley.

Coastal Flood Warnings have been issued for Kuskokwim Delta until 12:00 pm tomoorow, Yukon Deltal until 6:00am Saturday, Chukchi Sea Coast, Northern and Interior Seward Peninsula until 12:00 pm Saturday and Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Southern Seward Peninsula Coast and Baldwin Peninsula and Selawik Valley until 3:00 pm Saturday.

Coastal Flood Advisory is in effect until 6:00 P.M. Saturday St Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast and Coastal Flood Watch is in effect until 6:00 pm for Western Arctic Coast and 9:00 pm for Northern Arctic Coast.
