
Air Quality Index (AQI) Advisories

A Stage Two Alert is in effect for both the Fairbanks & North Pole Zones until 10:00 P.M. today.

Significant Weather:



A Blizzard Warning is in effect for Northeast Prince William Sound until 3:00 A.M. Friday. Total snow accumulations of 5 to 10 inches with winds gusting as high as 55 mph are expected in the area.

A High Wind Warning is in effect for the Southeast Gulf Coast, including the cities of Hydaburg, Craig, and Sitka until 9:00 P.M. today. Southeast winds 30 to 40 mph with gusts up to 60 mph are expected.

A Winter Storm Warning is in effect for the Haines Borough & Lynn Canal until 9:00 A.M. Friday. Heavy snow is expected along the Haines Highway near the Canadian border. Total snow accumulations of up to 12 inches are possible.

A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect for the following areas:

- Western Arctic Coast, Chukchi Sea Coast, St. Lawrence Island & Bering Strait Coast until 6:00 A.M. Saturday. Winds gusting as high as 40 mph will cause areas of blowing and drifting snow.
- Yukon Flats and Central Interior Region until noon tomorrow. Winds gusting as high as 40 mph will cause areas of blowing and drifting snow along summits on the Dalton and Steese Highways.
- Western Prince William Sound until 6:00 P.M. today. Total snow accumulations of 3 to 6 inches with up to 15 inches through Turnagain Pass with blowing snow and winds gusting as high as 45 mph.
- Taiya Inlet & the Klondike Highway until 9:00 A.M. tomorrow. Total snow accumulations
 of 6 to 10 inches with winds gusting as high as 35 mph. Areas of blowing snow will
 reduce visibility.

A Special Weather Statement has been issued for Kodiak Island. Strong winds with rain are expected to continue across the island throughout the day.
