## **Significant Issues:**

#### **SEOC Preparedness Level**

The SEOC has returned to SEOC Preparedness Level 1 – *Normal Operations* today as the COVID-19 response and the Buckland Flooding Disaster transition to Recovery. While the COVID-19 Response was managed by a Unified Incident Command structure, from multiple state departments, through the State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC), the COVID-19 Recovery will now be managed directly by the Alaska State Department of Health and Social Services with the ongoing support of Agency Representatives from the SEOC and other state departments as required.

# Magnitude 6.1 Southcentral Earthquake

On Saturday May 31, 2021 at 2259 hrs. a magnitude 6.1 earthquake occurred 55 miles north of Sutton, Alaska. The earthquake, at a depth of 36 miles, was widely felt in Southcentral Alaska. Immediately following the earthquake, the SEOC executed the large earthquake checklist and contacted communities within a 100-mile radius of the earthquake including the Mat-Su Borough Emergency Management, Mat-Su police and fire dispatch centers, Anchorage Emergency Management, and Anchorage Police and Fire Dispatch. No injuries or damage were reported. SEOC also contacted the Alaska Earthquake Center at the University of Alaska Fairbanks Geophysical Institute to receive a briefing on the earthquake mechanism and after-shock/fore-shock potential.



A Wind Advisory is in effect for the Eastern Alaska Range until midnight tonight. South winds of 40mph with gusts to 55mph are expected in the area.

A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect for the Southeastern Brooks Range until 10:00 A.M. Wednesday. 3 to 5 inches of snow is expected at elevations above 3000 feet.
