Interior Winter Storms - Disaster Assistance Centers

Delta Junction – Wednesday, February 23, through Thursday, February 24 from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm at the Delta Junction Community Center.

Fairbanks – Tuesday, March 1, through Thursday, March 3 from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm at the Fairbanks National Guard Armory.



Significant Weather:



Winter Storm Warnings are in effect today for the Central and Eastern Alaska Range, including Denali, for heavy snow.

Winter Storm Warnings are in effect for and portions of the southeast panhandle, and Winter Weather Advisories for the remainder of the southeast panhandle, for heavy snow.

The Winter Storm Warning for the Susitna Valley has expired.

Winter Weather Advisories are currently in effect for much of the Central and Eastern Interior, expiring from west to east today.

Winter Weather Advisories are in effect from Wednesday morning to Thursday morning for the Lower Yukon Valley and the Yukon Delta. Mixed precipitation of snow and ice is expected.
