#### River Watch 2022

The SEOC Kuskokwim Division Supervisor deployed to Bethel yesterday to meet with local, regional and tribal organizations in Bethel to discuss emergency flood plans. Additional personnel will travel to Bethel tomorrow and daily River Watch flights will begin to observe river ice conditions and potential ice jam flooding concerns. Bi-weekly incident specific River Watch Situation Reports will be produced on Tuesday and Thursday each week and disseminated the following day.
