Significant Weather:




The following Winter Weather Advisories are in effect:

- Western Arctic Coast for Blowing and drifting snow with low visibility, wind chills to 45 below and east winds 20 to 30 mph until 6:00PM this afternoon.
- Municipality of Skagway and Klondike Highway, Haines Borough and Klukwan for Heavy snow possible. Total snow accumulations of up to 1 inch for Skagway, 5 inches near Haines and up to 11 inches possible near White Pass and near Pleasant Camp through 6:00PM this afternoon.
