Significant Issues:

Alaska Earthquake

This morning, at 0647, a magnitude 4.7 earthquake was widely felt in the Anchorage area. There were no reports of damage.

Severed Offshore Internet Cable – Utqiagvik

SEOC continues to participate in regular interagency calls coordinating response operations to the damaged fiber optic communications line on the North Slope.

2023 Spring Floods Disaster

The Disaster Assistance Centers in Fort Yukon, Kwethluk, and Russian Mission have demobilized after completing Individual Assistance registrations, inspections, and Public Assistance damage reviews in preparation for the joint Preliminary Damage Assessments with the Federal Emergency Management Agency slated for next week.

To date the state has received 219 total disaster Individual Assistance registrations. Deadline for Registration has been extended to July 23, 2023.
