2023 Spring Floods Disaster

SEOC is meeting with the Federal Emergency Management Agency and State Public & Individual Assistance today in preparation for the Joint Preliminary Damage Assessments later this week.

Whittier Boat and Fuel Dock Fire

SEOC received an update from Whittier's Harbor Master over the weekend: shoreside has their fueling capacity up with two pumps operating on both the east and west side of the dock and no longer must run hoses down the gangway. They hope to have the new pumps installed and operational by Friday of next week.


