Ongoing Utility Disruptions

SEOC is actively working with multiple state partners, Alaska Energy Authority (AEA), Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC), Tanana Chiefs Conference (TCC), and other regional tribal partners on the ongoing utility disruptions effecting multiple communities due to severe winter weather throughout the state.


Avalanche Hazards:
