Significant Issues:

Sand Point - Structure Fire

SEOC was notified that Sand Point experienced a structure fire at the Peter Pan Seafood warehouse and office building. With the help of Trident providing a water pump, firefighters were able to save the office building, but the warehouse was a total loss. The airport borders on the warehouse property and temporarily lost power due to the fire. SEOC notified DEC, AST, and the Fire Marshall's office of the fire. No injuries were reported, and no immediate needs were identified. SEOC will continue to monitor the situation and stand ready to assist.

Kotzebue – Frozen Water Lines

Yesterday afternoon DEC emailed SEOC regarding a water line break in Kotzebue. DEC reports there are 189 homes without water and 33 homes have frozen service lines. SEOC is closely monitoring emerging events and remains in open communication.

Chalkyitsik – Power Outage

AEA confirms they have had a technician in the community since Saturday working to restore power. Additional needed parts were identified, and repairs continue.

Koyukuk – Freeze Up

SEOC is actively engaged with multiple partner agencies including the city, Koyukuk Native Village, Salvation Army, TCC, and the VOADs. TCC Remote Maintenance Workers (RMW) continue to work on repairs to the water pump and water plant.

Mertarvik – Power Outage

SEOC confirmed with Fox Air that 1,080 pounds of bottled water and 1,600 pounds of firewood has been delivered to the community and that the supplies are already getting distributed out within the community.




Avalanche Hazards:
