Significant Issues:

City of Anderson – Waterwater Collection System

SEOC received a disaster declaration from the Denali Borough and the City of Anderson. SEOC, the borough, city officials, as well as other agency representatives continue to have open communication regarding the community's emergency response and recovery.

Kotzebue - Frozen Water Lines

SEOC has a staff member deployed in support of the continued coordination of response and recovery. An applicant brief provided by the state disaster assistance team is scheduled with the community this morning, which the SEOC staff member will attend, then plans to return to Anchorage and continue support from here.




Avalanche Hazards:
