Significant Issues:

Kotzebue Water Freeze-up State Disaster

Last Friday, Governor Dunleavy amended the State Disaster declaration for Kotzebue to include the Individual Assistance and Temporary Housing Program. This is in response to additional residential damages discovered following thawing operations from the February 8, 2024 water line freeze-up. State Disaster Individual Assistance Program will be implemented next week.



Avalanche Hazard




Travel in avalanche terrain is not recommended. Avoid being on or beneath all steep slopes.
