

High wind warnings are in effect for the following areas:

- Downtown Juneau and South Douglas – in effect from midnight tonight until 4 PM Tuesday for localized Taku wind gusts around 60 MPH or higher.
- Chukchi Sea Coast from Kivalina north – in effect from midnight tonight through 6 PM Tuesday.
- St Lawrence Island and Bering Sea Coast – in effect from midnight tonight through 6 PM Tuesday.
- Western Aleutians east of Shemya – in effect until 7 PM this evening for south wind 45 to 60 MPH with gusts to 80 MPH.
- Central Aleutians – in effect from 1 PM today through 10 PM this evening for south wind 40 to 55 MPH with gusts 60 to 80 MPH.

Coastal Flood Watch is in effect for the Kuskokwim Delta from Tuesday morning through Tuesday afternoon, with the potential for water levels to reach 1 to 3 feet above maximum astronomical high tide.

High Surf advisories are in effect for the following areas:

- St Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast – in effect from midnight tonight through 10 AM Tuesday.
- Southern Seward Peninsula Coast – in effect from 6 AM to 6 PM Tuesday.
- Yukon Delta – in effect from 6 AM to 6 PM Tuesday.
