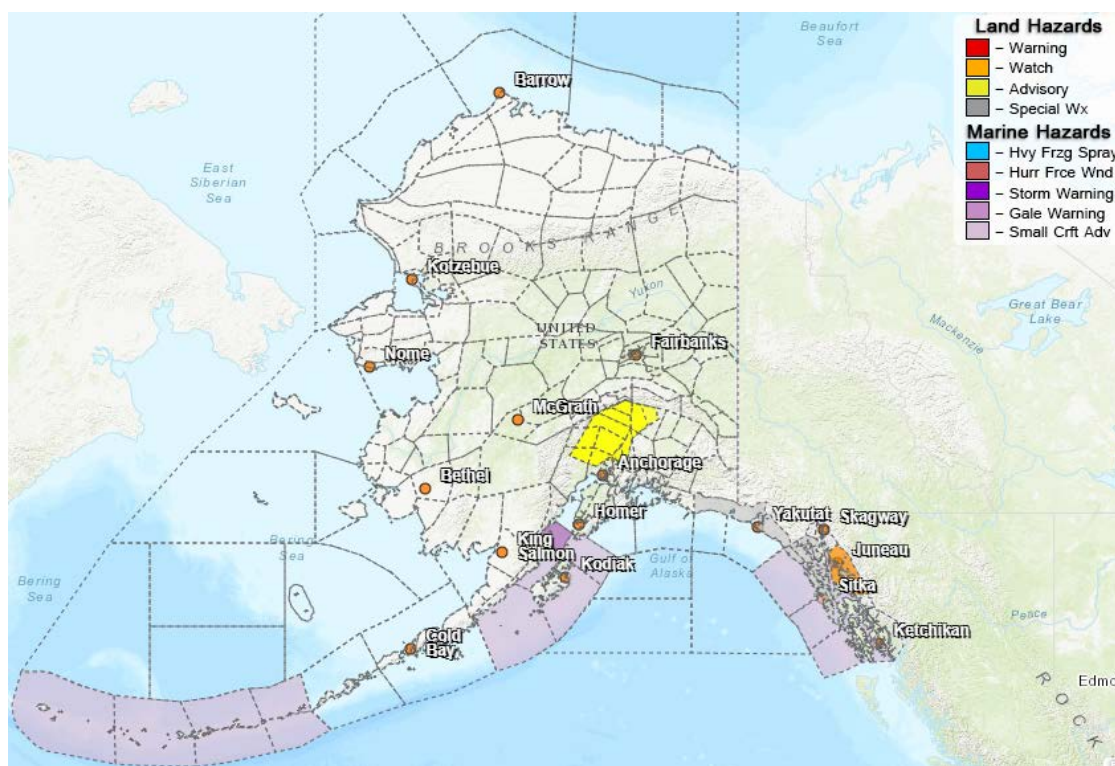
#### Statewide Cyber Incidents

The SEOC continues to monitor the response and recovery efforts by Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) and the City of Valdez to their respective cyber incidents. The City of Valdez forwarded a draft local declaration with request for state assistance to the SEOC earlier this week; a final request is expected from the city in the next couple days.

#### Tuluksak Power Outage

The Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) confirms the power was restored in Tuluksak on Friday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>. The AEA contractor, Current River, should be on site today to replace the engine wiring harness and all fuel components.

A flood watch has been issued for Juneau Borough and Northern Admiralty Island.

There is a flood warning for the Taiya Inlet and Klondike highway.

There is a flood advisory for the Copper River Basin, middle Tanana Valley, and the Matanuska-Susitna Valleys.
