Objectives

Ensure the safety and security of responders as well as maximize the protection of public health and welfare.

Prevent the spread of COVID-19 in Alaska by implementing statewide containment and community mitigation strategies.

Support local emergency response operations through the coordination of information, situational reporting and resource requests.

Keep the public, stakeholders and the media informed of operational activities and address rumors or incorrect information in a timely manner.

Maintain statewide medical surge capacity to include Alternate Care Site facilities.

Maintain COVID-19 specimen collection centers and point of care testing sites statewide.

Objectives
Implement the Governor's health mandates.
Support the Governor's phased "Reopen Alaska Responsibly" plan assisting Alaska to return to normal operations.
Prepare to support non-COVID-19 response operations, as necessary.

Significant Weather Impacts for Transportation

Anchorage & Mat-Su

- Showers, some clearing on Tuesday. MVFR thru mountain passes.
- High water thru Monday in the Matsu Valley and along Denali Hwy.

Gulf Coast Region

- Rain turning to showers on Tuesday afternoon. MVR with IFR condition along the North Gulf Coast.

Southwest

- Scattered showers. IFR early MVFR in the afternoon.

Interior

- Scattered showers, evening thunderstorms.
- Delta Junction: Isolated showers and afternoon thunderstorms. Quarter to half inch rain thru Tuesday.
- Flood watch for Central Intr. & middle Tanana Valley thru tonight.

Northern

- Fog, low ceilings and poor visibility. Some clearing in the afternoon. IFR along the coast. Areas or MVFR in the afternoon.

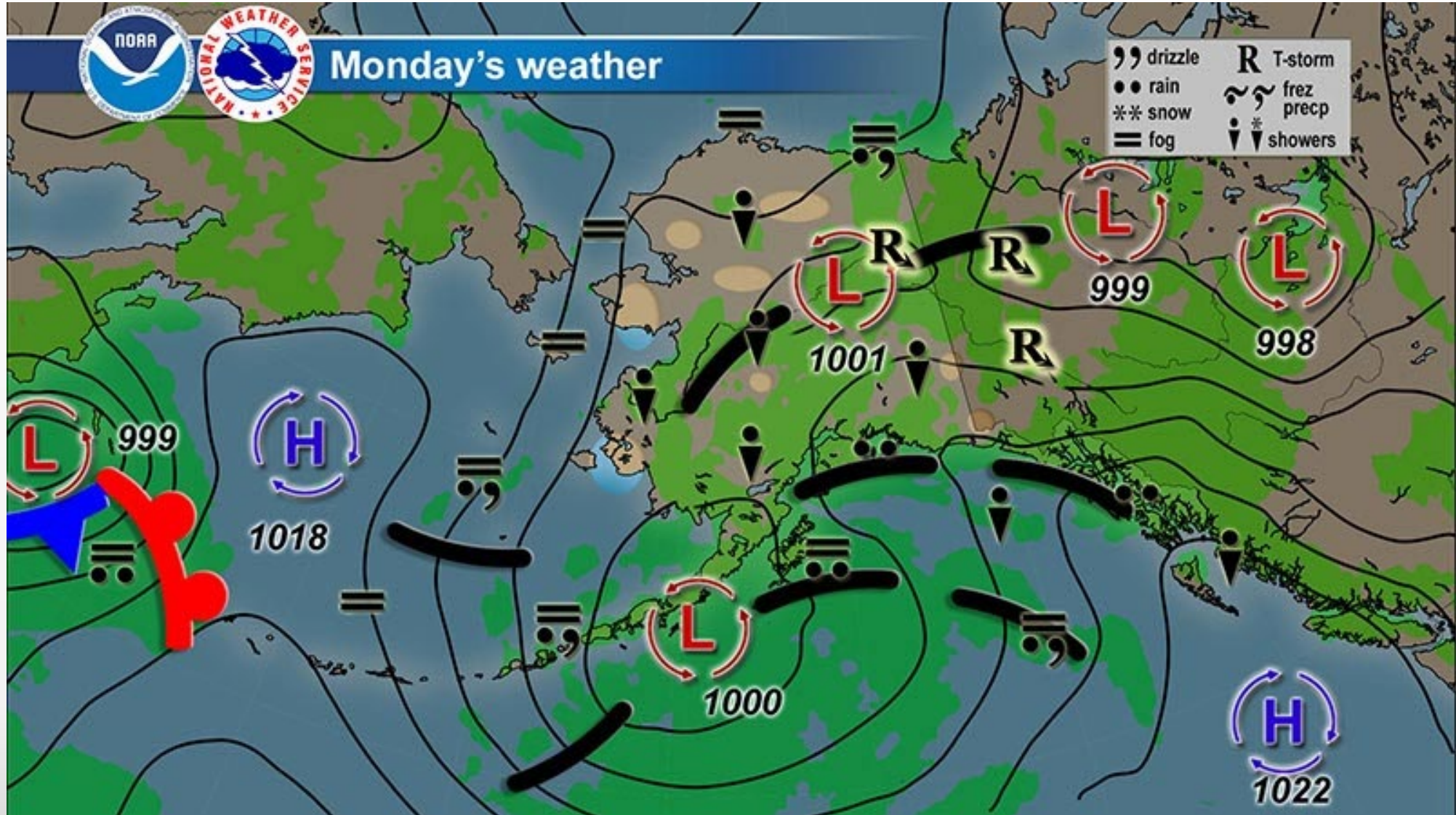
Southeast

- Showers turning to rain on Tuesday. MVFR turning to IFR Tuesday. .



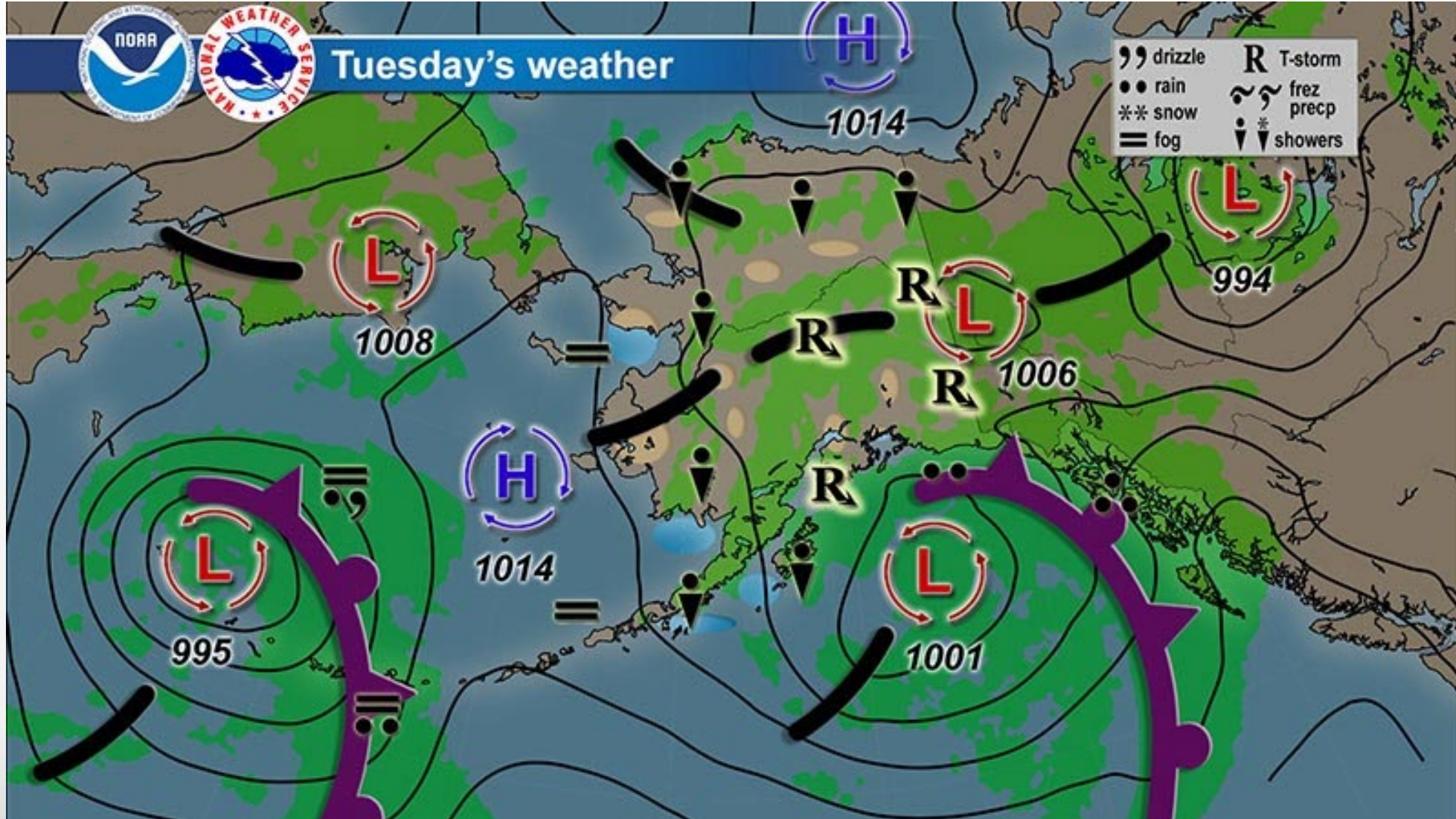


Today's Afternoon Weather



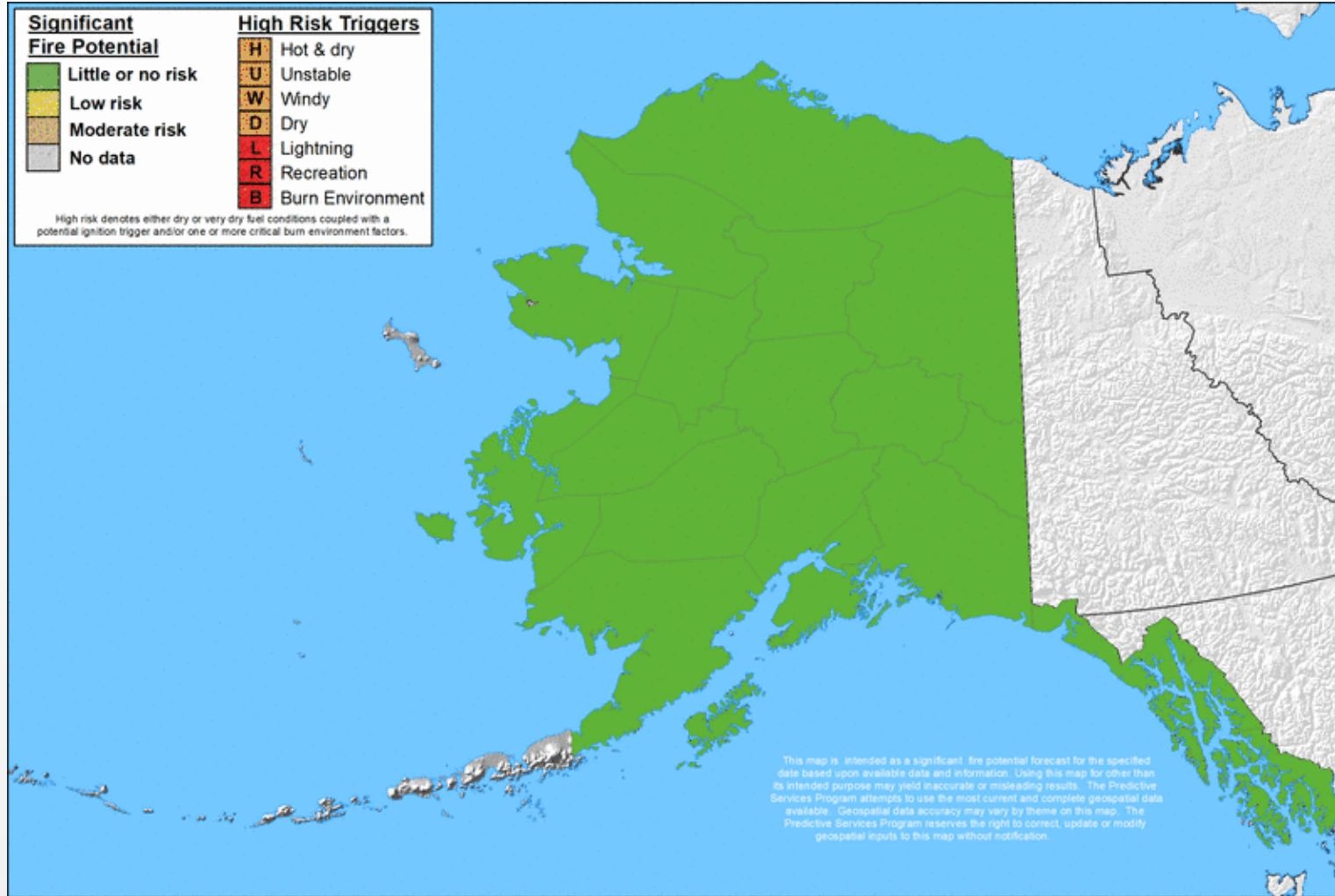


Tomorrow's Afternoon Weather

SIGNIFICANT FIRE POTENTIAL

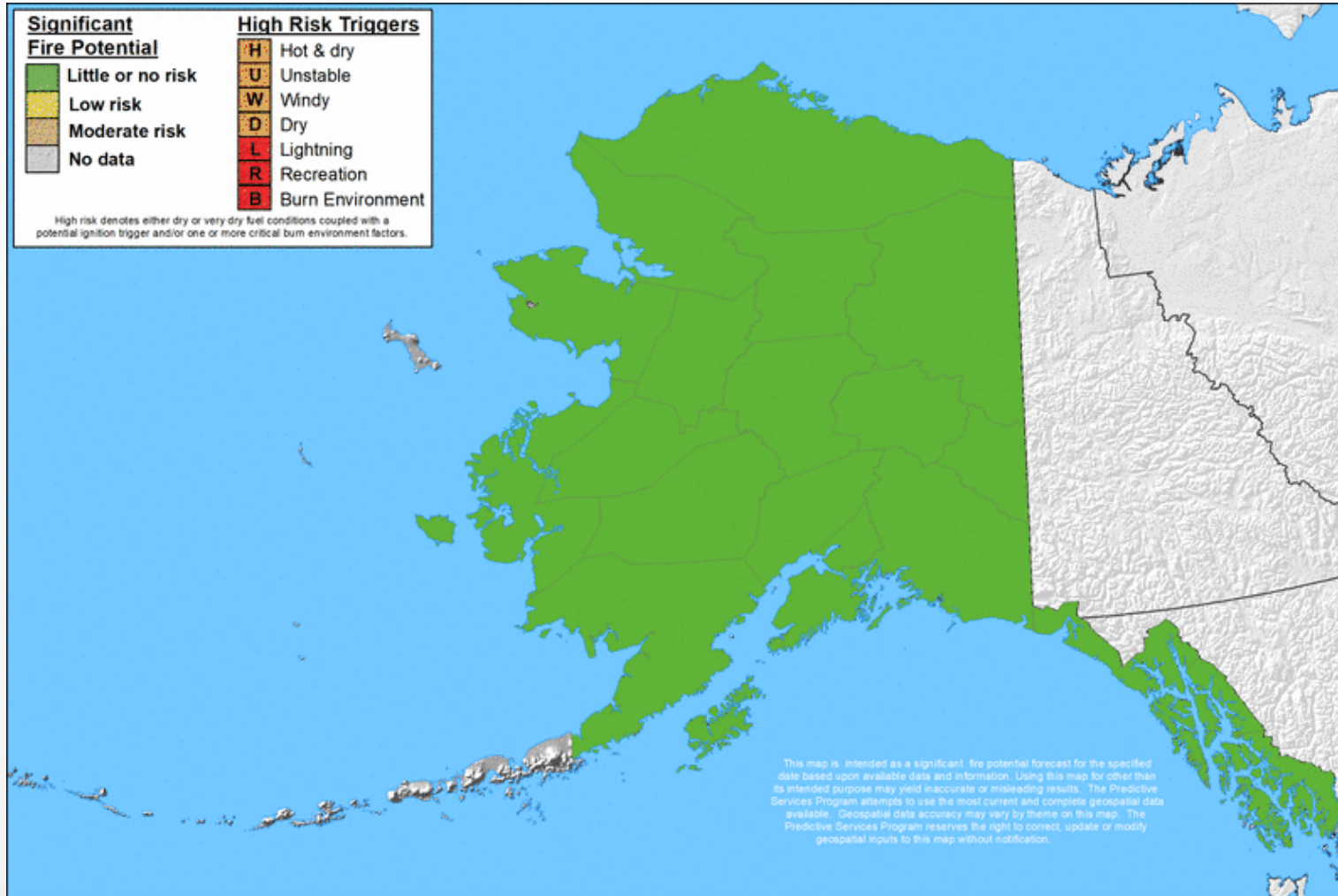

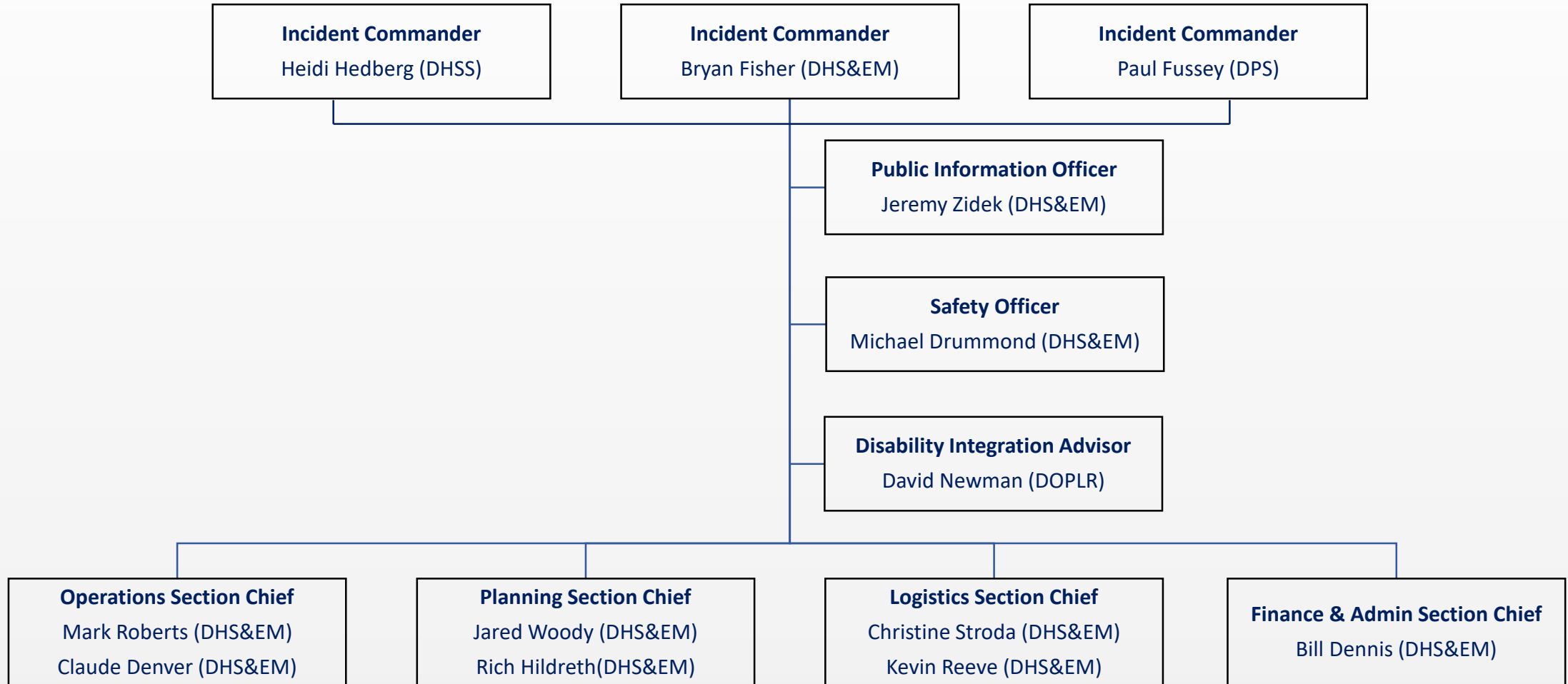

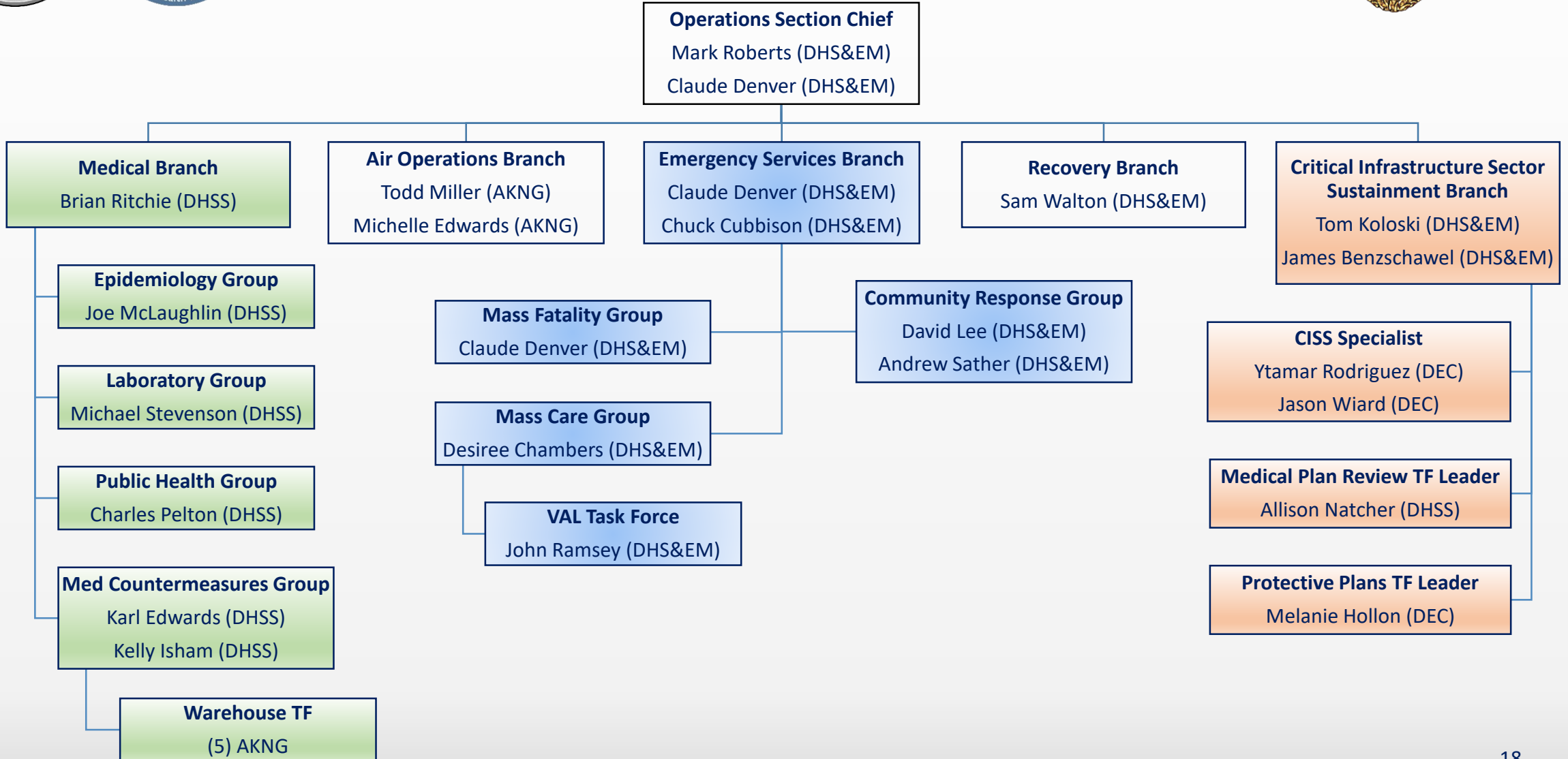
