# Incident Objectives



## Objectives

Ensure the safety and security of responders as well as maximize the protection of public health and welfare.

Prevent the spread of COVID-19 in Alaska by implementing statewide containment and community mitigation strategies.

Support local emergency response operations through the coordination of information, situational reporting and resource requests.

Keep the public, stakeholders and the media informed of operational activities and address rumors or incorrect information in a timely manner.

Maintain statewide medical surge capacity to include Alternate Care Site facilities.

Maintain COVID-19 specimen collection centers and point of care testing sites statewide.

## Objectives

Implement the Governor's health mandates.

Support the Governor's phased "Reopen Alaska Responsibly" plan assisting Alaska to return to normal operations.

Prepare to support non-COVID-19 response operations, as necessary.

# Significant Weather Impacts for Transportation

## Anchorage & Mat-Su

- Isolated Showers.
- Rain for the weekend with occasional MVFR.

## Gulf Coast Region

- Rain. MVFR with occasional IFR.
- Kodiak IFR this morning and MVFR Saturday.

## Southwest

- Scattered showers. MVFR occasional IFR, then mostly VFR on Sunday.

## Interior

- Scattered showers. Isolated afternoon & evening thunderstorms. VFR.
- Delta Junction: Isolated showers. Levee holding. River level low. Little or no rainfall.

## Northern

- Fog, low ceilings and poor visibility. Some clearing in the afternoon. LIFR along the coast. Areas or MVFR in the afternoon. Sunday maybe VFR.

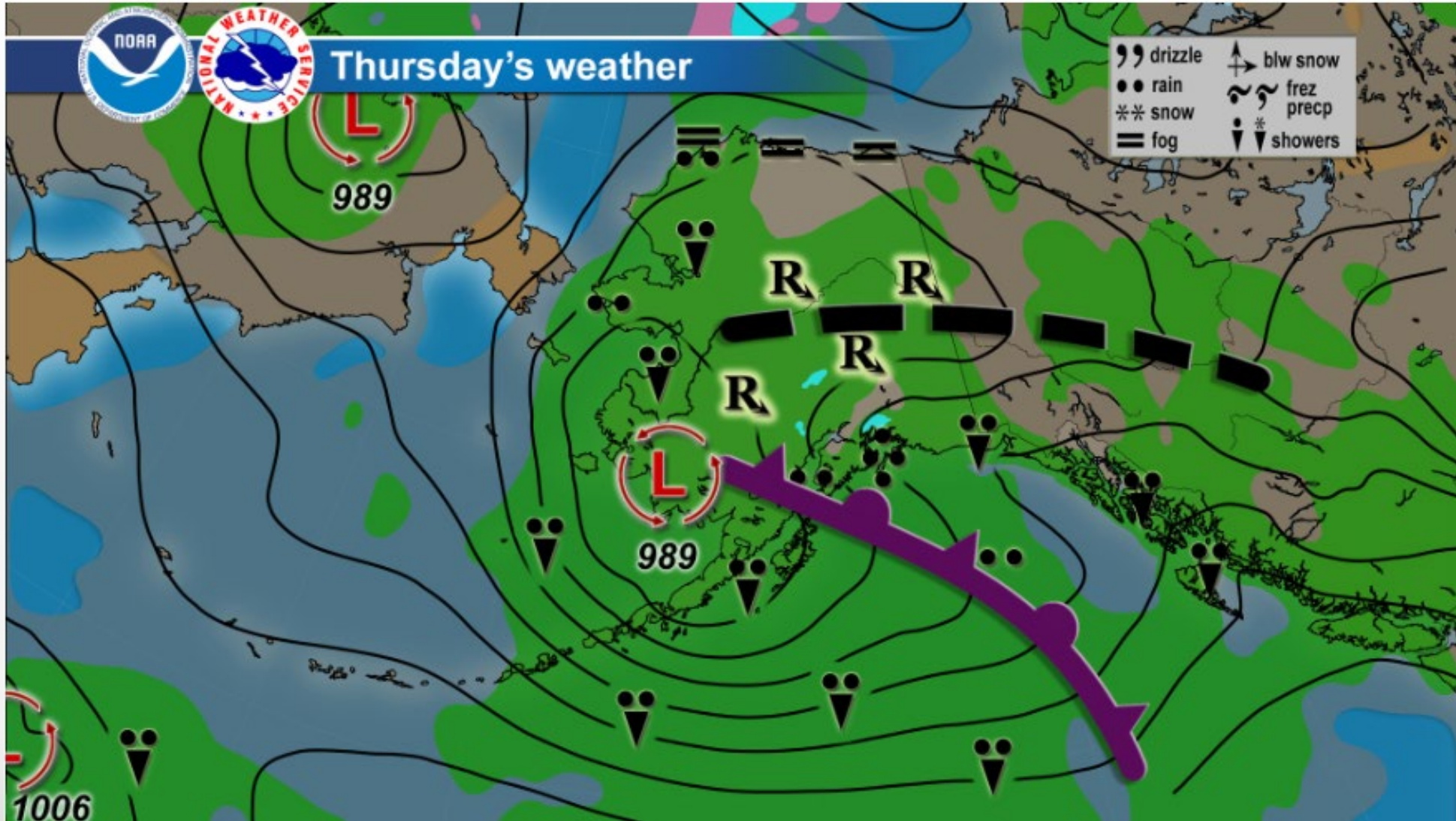
## Southeast

- Rain. MVFR. LIFR at times.





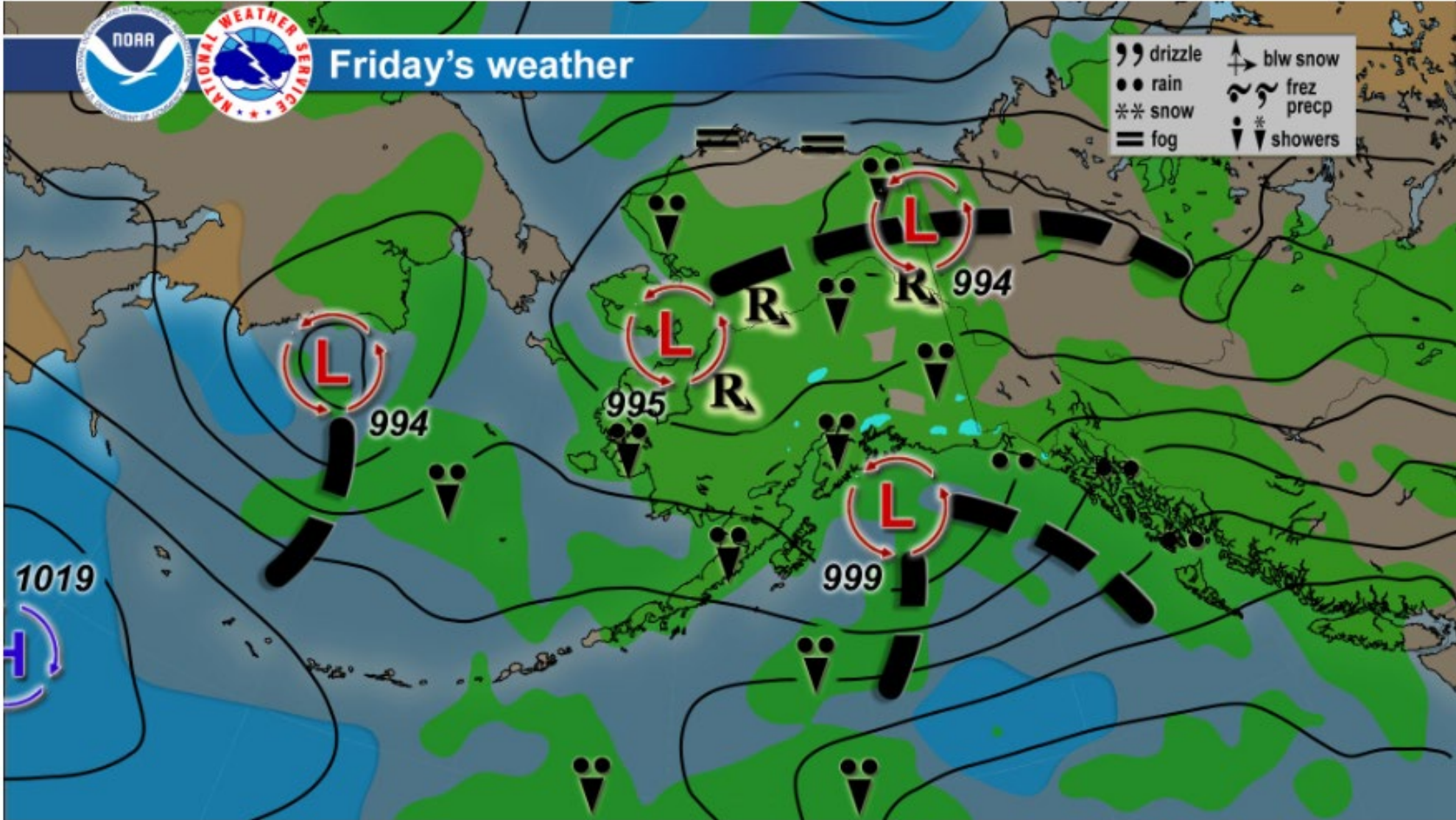

# Tomorrow's Afternoon Weather



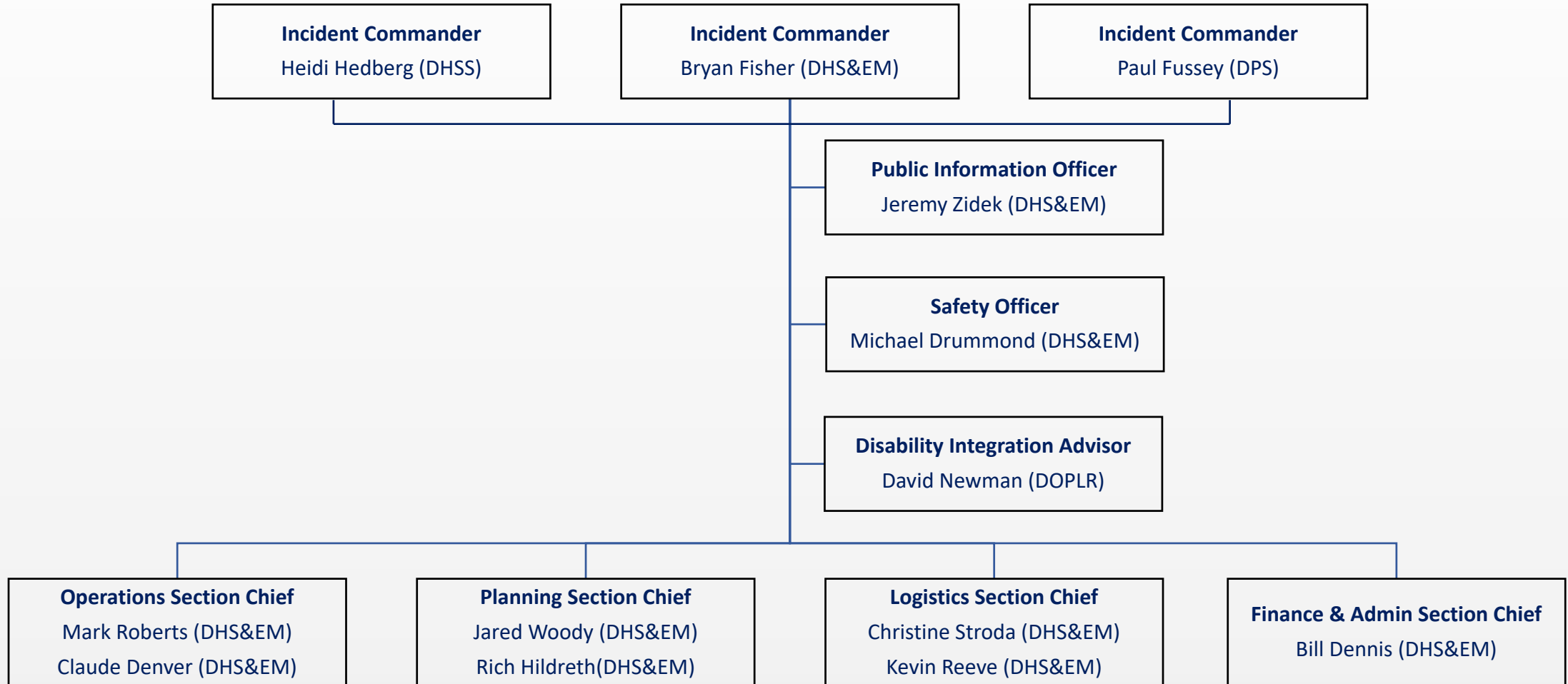

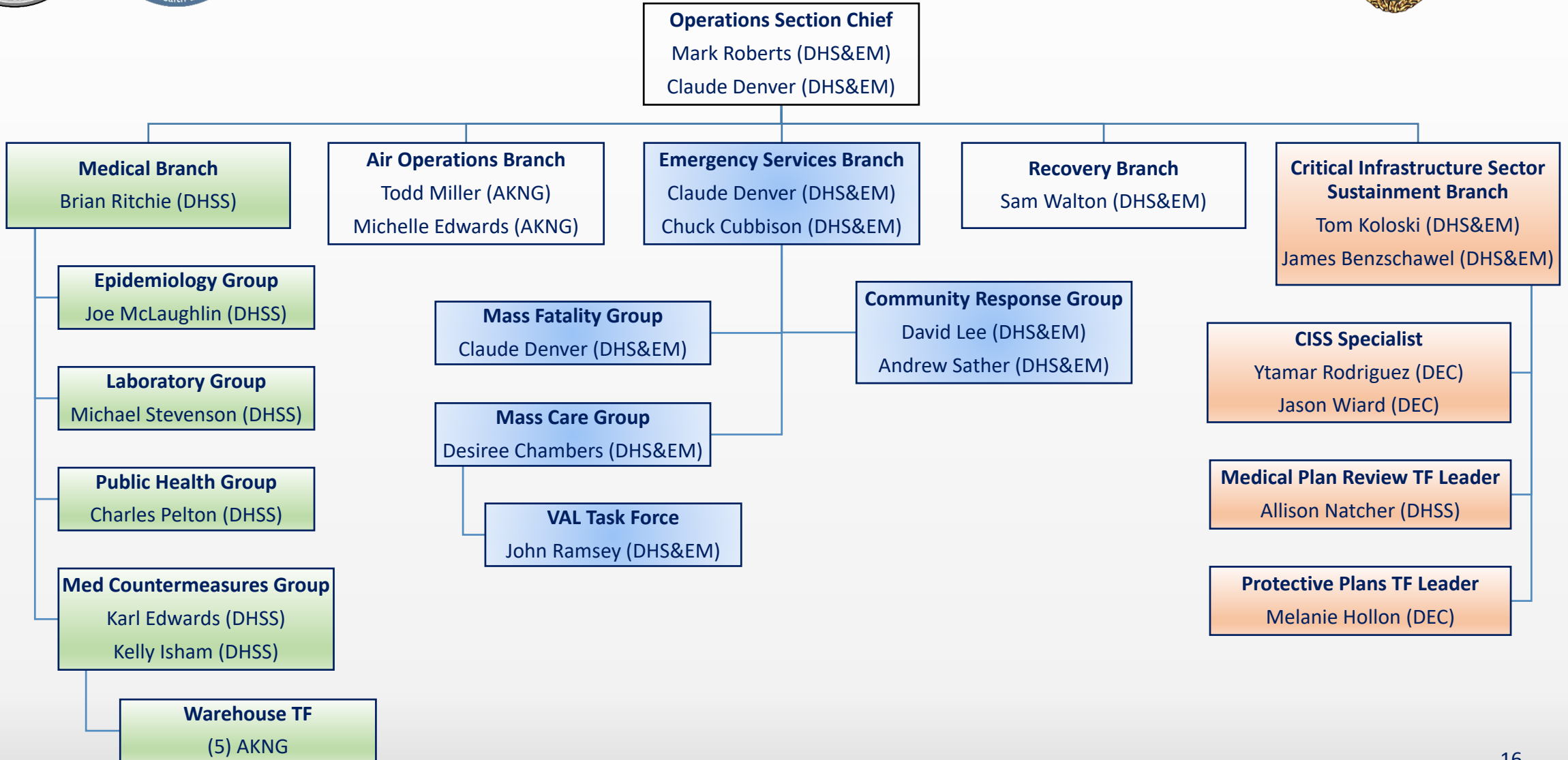
