## Objectives

Ensure the safety and security of responders as well as maximize the protection of public health and welfare.

Prevent the spread of COVID-19 in Alaska by implementing statewide containment and community mitigation strategies.

Support local emergency response operations through the coordination of information, situational reporting and resource requests.

Keep the public, stakeholders and the media informed of operational activities and address rumors or incorrect information in a timely manner.

Maintain statewide medical surge capacity to include Alternate Care Site facilities.

Maintain COVID-19 specimen collection centers and point of care testing sites statewide.

Implement the Governor's health mandates.
Support the Governor's phased "Reopen Alaska Responsibly" plan assisting Alaska to return to normal operations.
Prepare to support non-COVID-19 response operations, as necessary.

# Significant Weather Impacts for Transportation

## Anchorage & Mat-Su

- No significant weather, isolated T-storm in the afternoon

## Gulf Coast Region

- No significant weather. MVFR near coastal areas mainly in the morning

## Southwest

- No significant weather, some MVFR conditions near coastal areas especially in the morning

## Interior

- Showers, more numerous in the afternoon. Isolated evening T-storms. Areas of MVFR E. Interior, some morning fog in the valleys

## Northern

- Patchy fog, low ceilings and poor visibility along the coast. Some clearing in the afternoon. LIFR along the coast, IFR otherwise with improvements to MVFR or VFR in the afternoons.

## Southeast

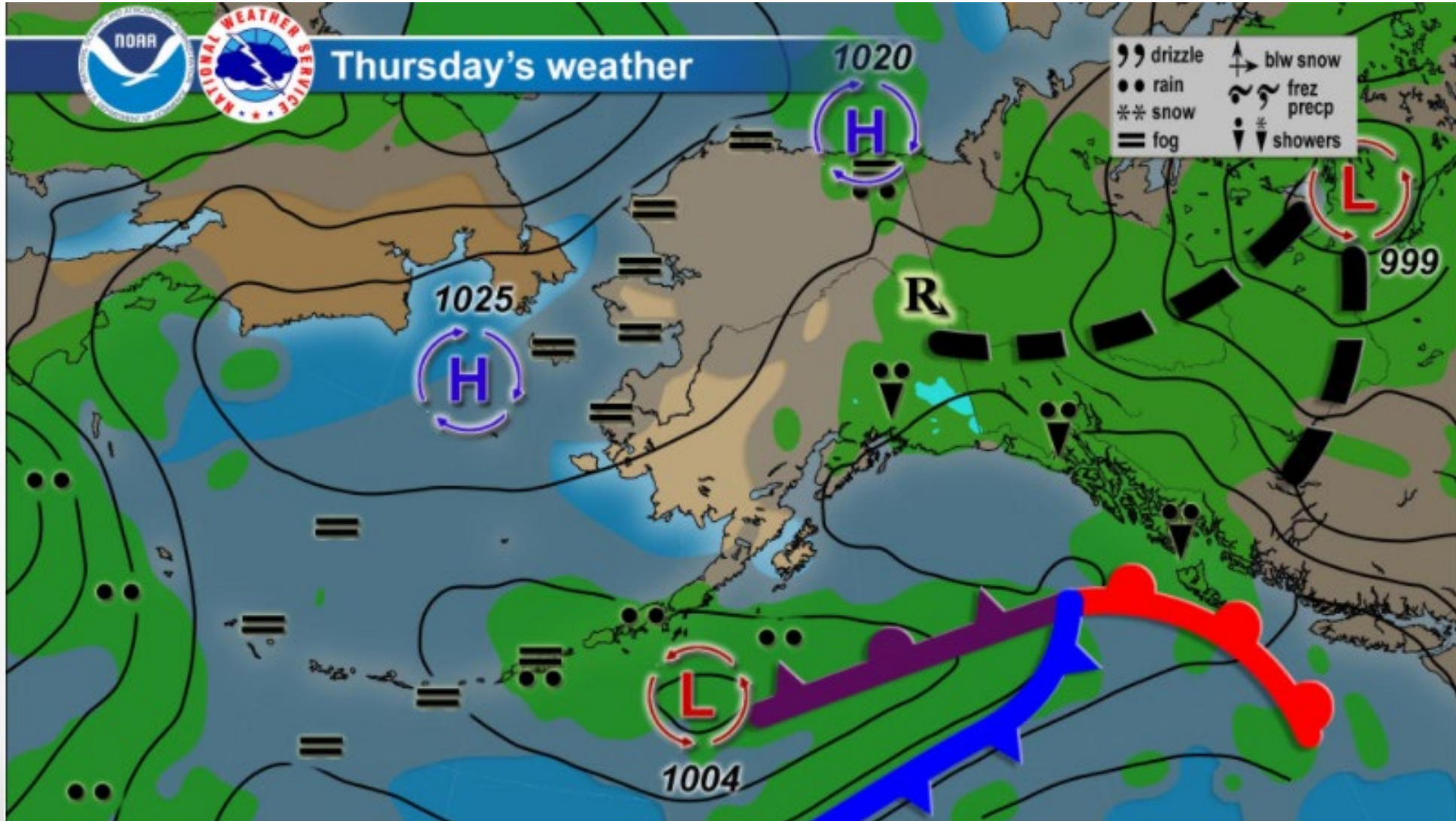
- Showers on Thursday turning to rain on Friday and continuing thru the weekend. Locally heavy rain southern end. MVFR/VFR turning to IFR Friday.







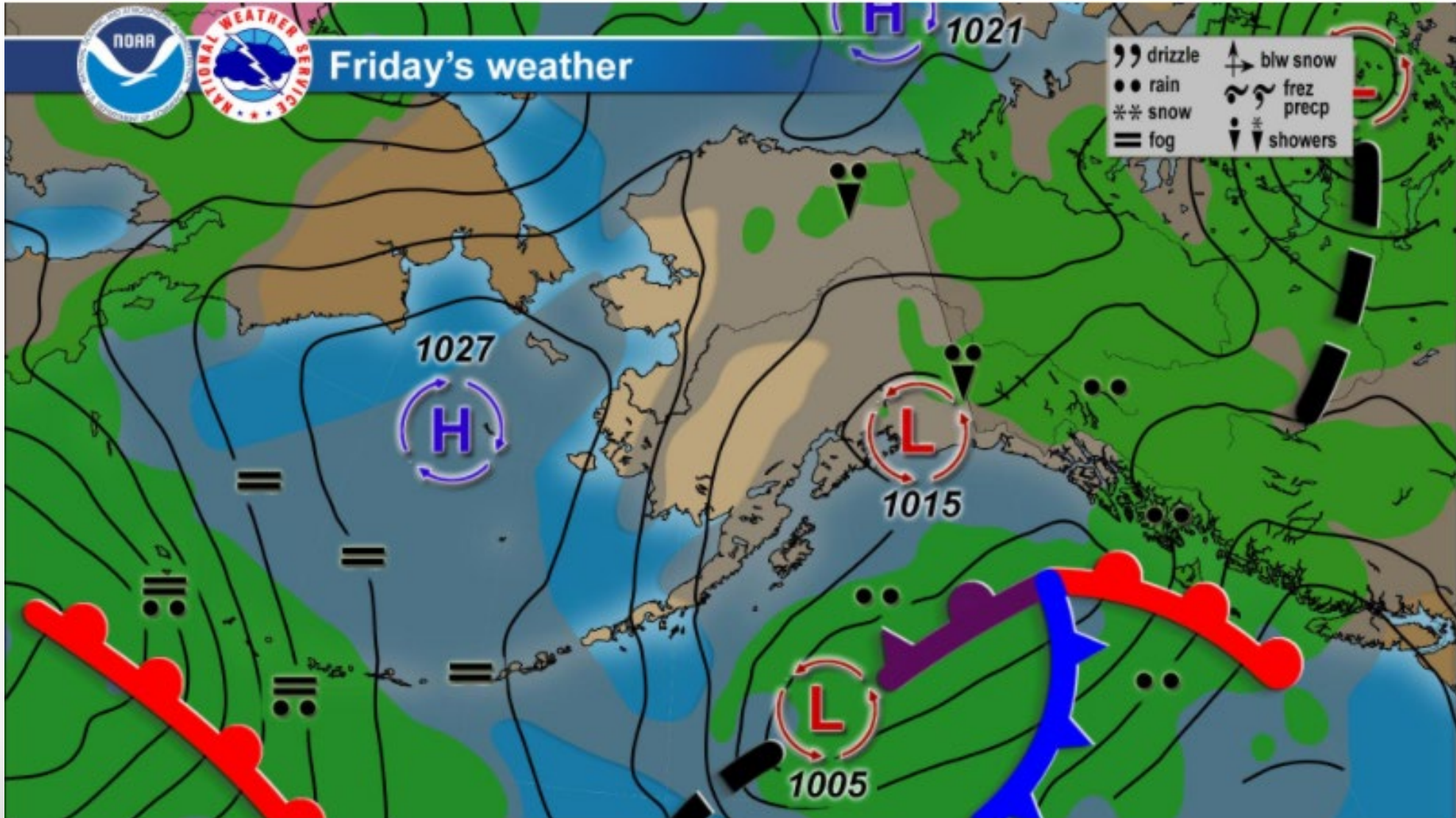
# Today's Afternoon Weather







# Tomorrow's Afternoon Weather



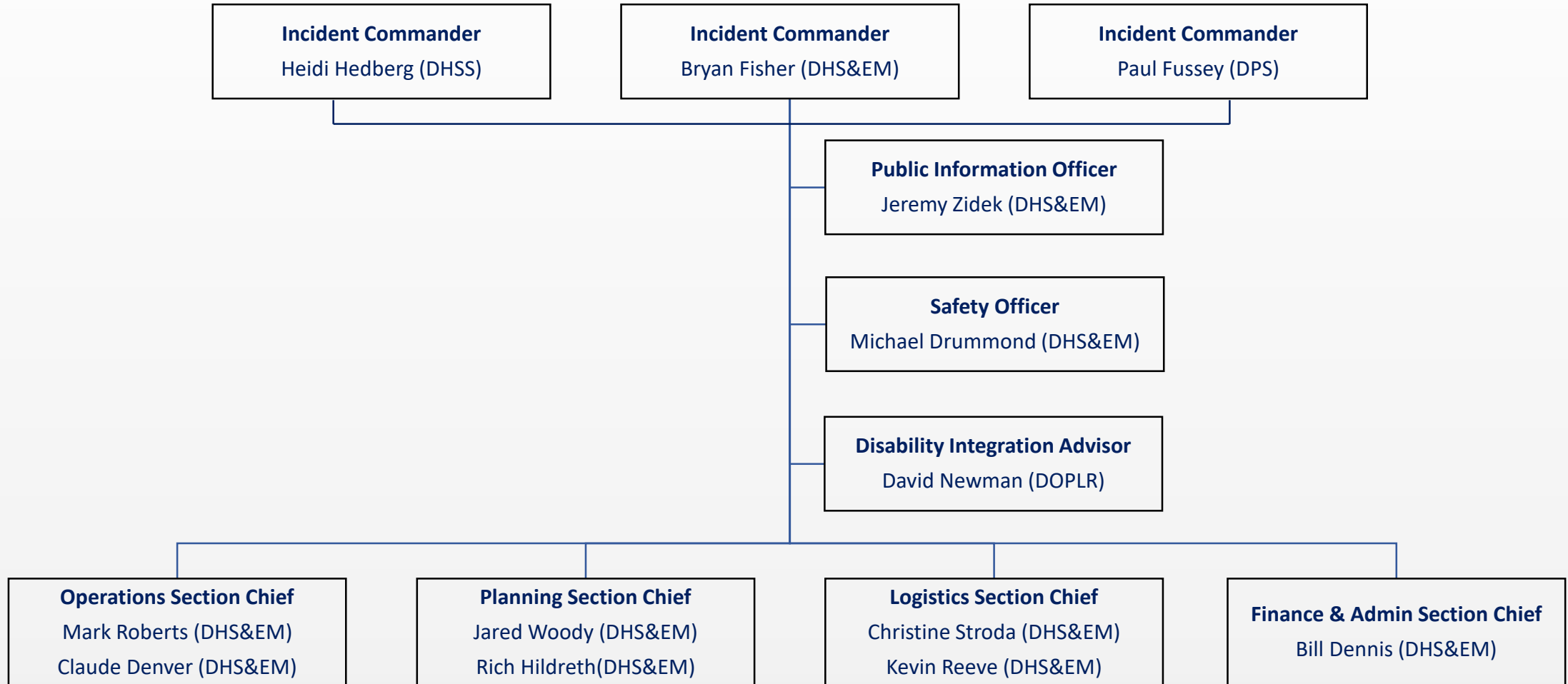

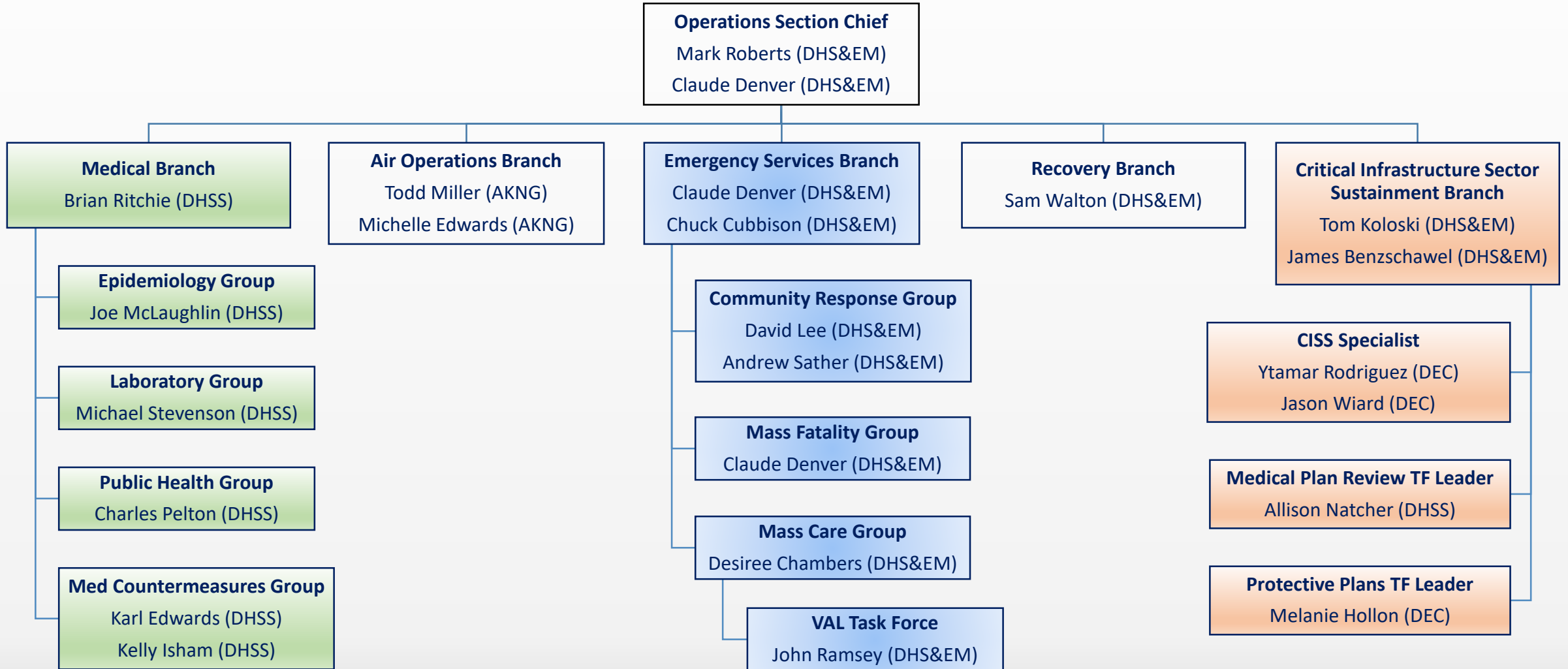
