Incident Objectives



Objectives

Ensure the safety and security of responders as well as maximize the protection of public health and welfare.

Prevent the spread of COVID-19 in Alaska by implementing statewide containment and community mitigation strategies.

Support local emergency response operations through the coordination of information, situational reporting and resource requests.

Maintain statewide medical surge capacity to include Alternate Care Site facilities **and staffing**.

Develop and submit draft State COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution and Management Plan by October 1, 2020.



Incident Objectives (cont.)

Objectives
Support communities in the development of local COVID-19 distribution and management plans to include public information, local distribution resources, and ensuring vaccine access to all members of the community.
Maintain COVID-19 specimen collection centers and point of care testing sites statewide.
Implement the Governor’s health mandates.
Support the Governor’s phased “Reopen Alaska Responsibly” plan assisting Alaska to return to normal operations.
Keep the public, stakeholders and the media informed of operational activities and address rumors or incorrect information in a timely manner.
Prepare to support non-COVID-19 response operations, as necessary.

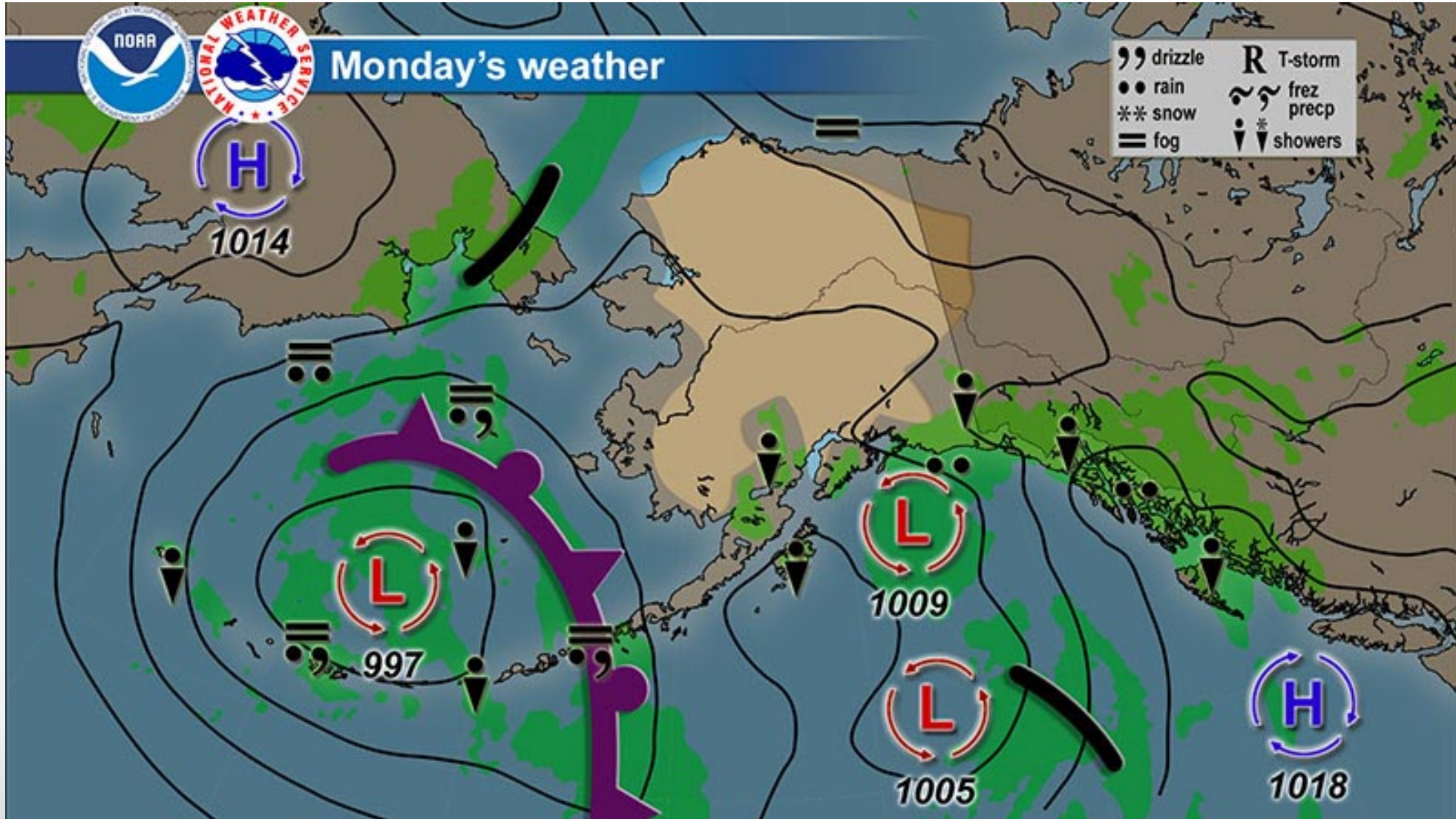
- North Slope: Morning IFR flight conditions

- MVFR/IFR flight conditions Tue & Wed

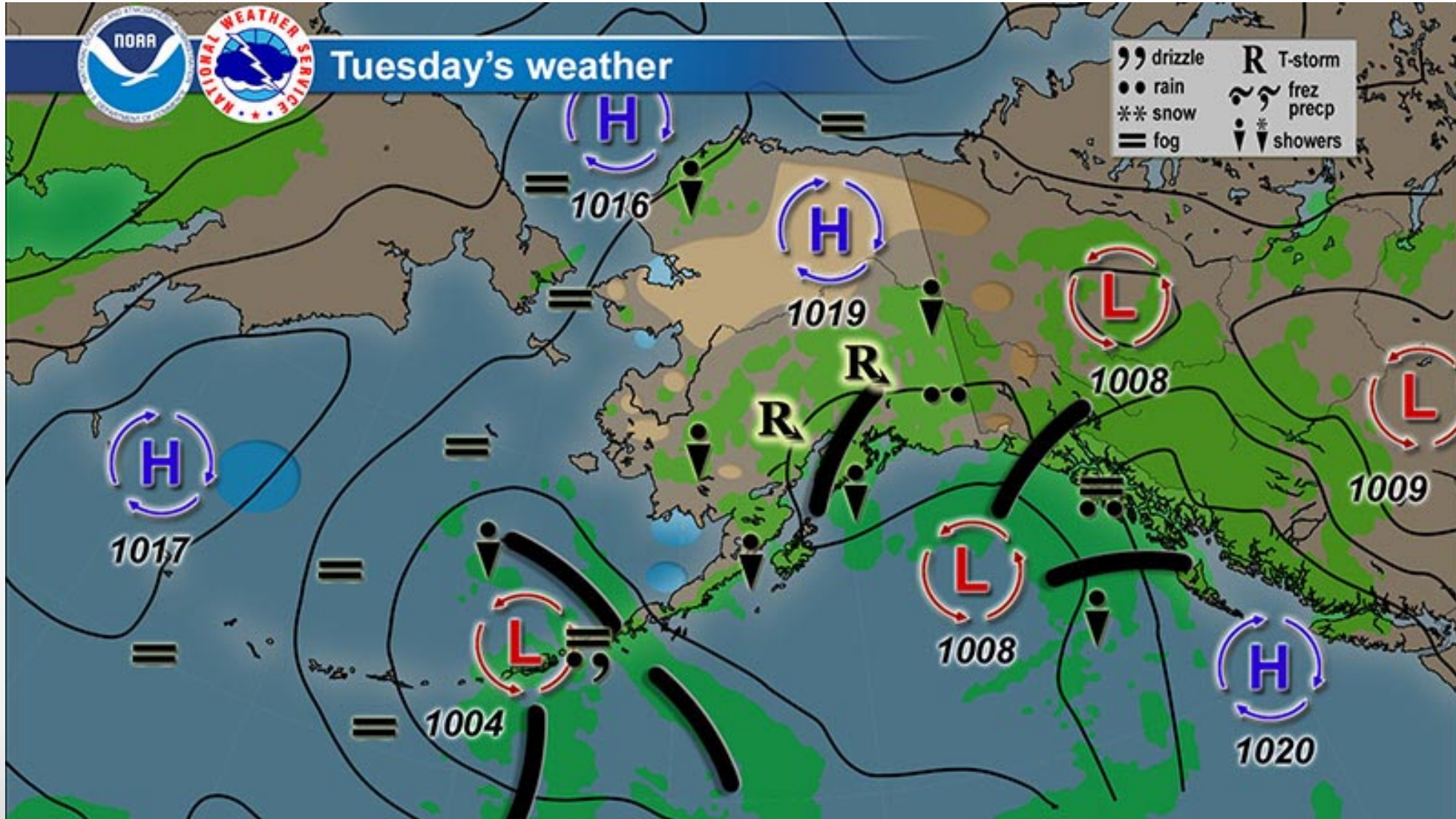

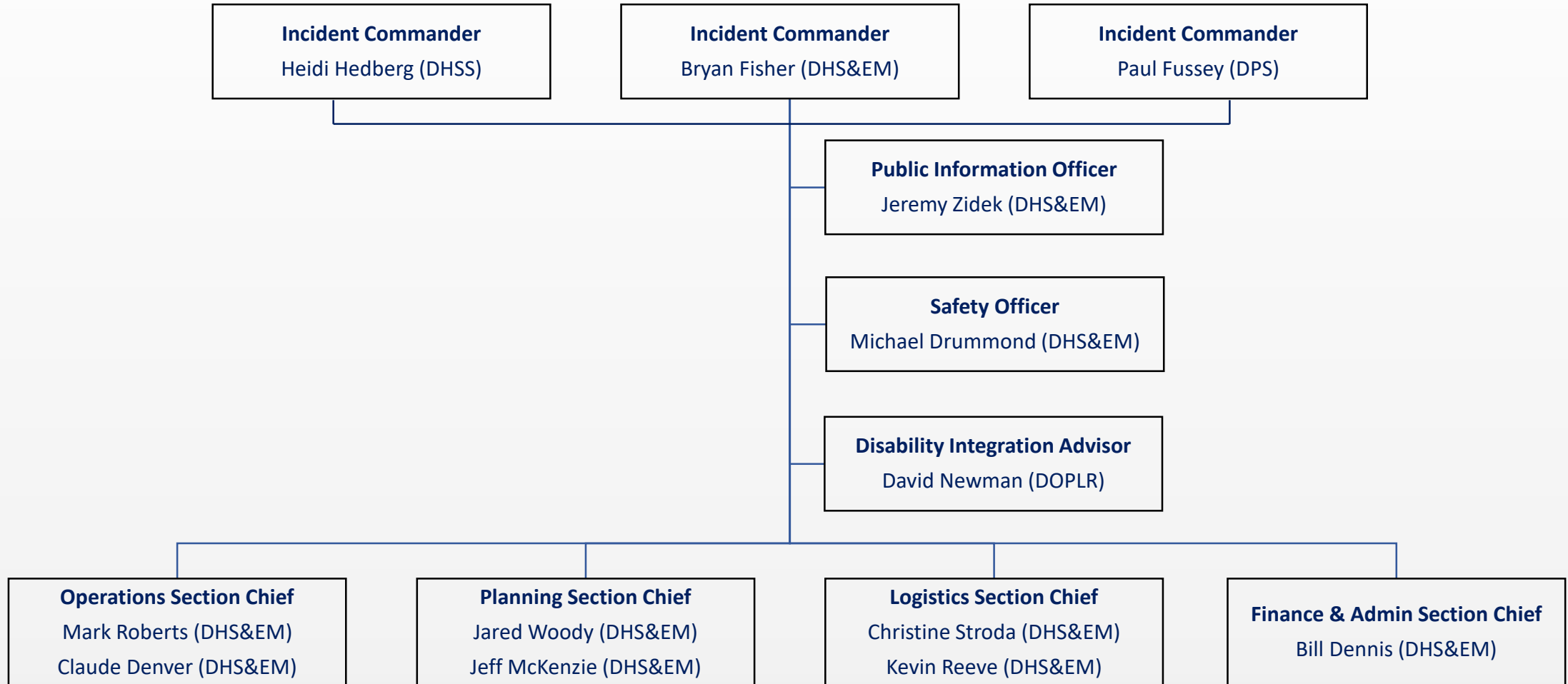

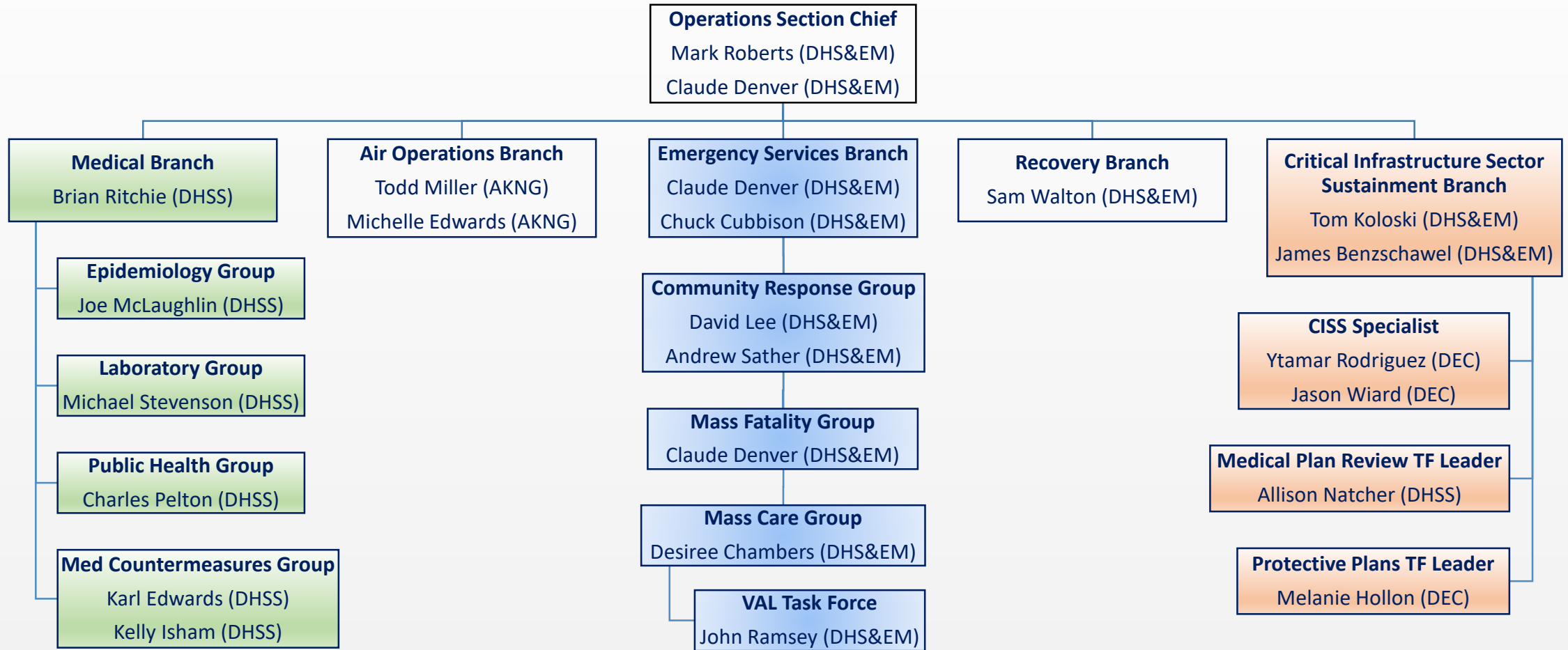
