Objectives

Ensure the safety and security of responders as well as maximize the protection of public health and welfare.

Prevent the spread of COVID-19 in Alaska by implementing statewide containment and community mitigation strategies.

Support local emergency response operations through the coordination of information, situational reporting and resource requests.

Maintain statewide medical surge capacity to include Alternate Care Site facilities and staffing.

Execute State COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution and Management Plan.



Incident Objectives (cont.)



Objectives
Support communities in the execution of local COVID-19 distribution and management plans to include public information, local distribution resources, and ensuring vaccine access to all members of the community.
Maintain COVID-19 specimen collection centers and point of care testing sites statewide.
Implement the Governor's health orders.
Keep the public, stakeholders and the media informed of operational activities and address rumors or incorrect information in a timely manner.
Continue supporting non-COVID-19 response operations, as necessary.

Significant Weather Impacts for Transportation

Anchorage & Mat-Su

- High Wind Warning ANC Bowl until 4pm. Rain and snow in the aftn and evening.
- Areas of IFR flying with severe turbulence this morning

West Coast

- High surf/coastal flooding Wednesday
- Heavy snow and blowing snow Wednesday. Advisory further inland
- IFR flight conditions esp. Wednesday.
- Areas of icing and turbulence this morning
- Hazardous driving out of Nome

Interior

- Snow across the interior Wed evening into Thur. High wind thru the AK Range today.
- IFR flight conditions Thursday.

Northern

- Blowing snow reduced visibility along the coast today
- Intermittent IFR conditions along the coast today

Gulf Coast Region

- Rain and snow depending on elevation. Strong winds, areas turbulence and IFR flight conditions today

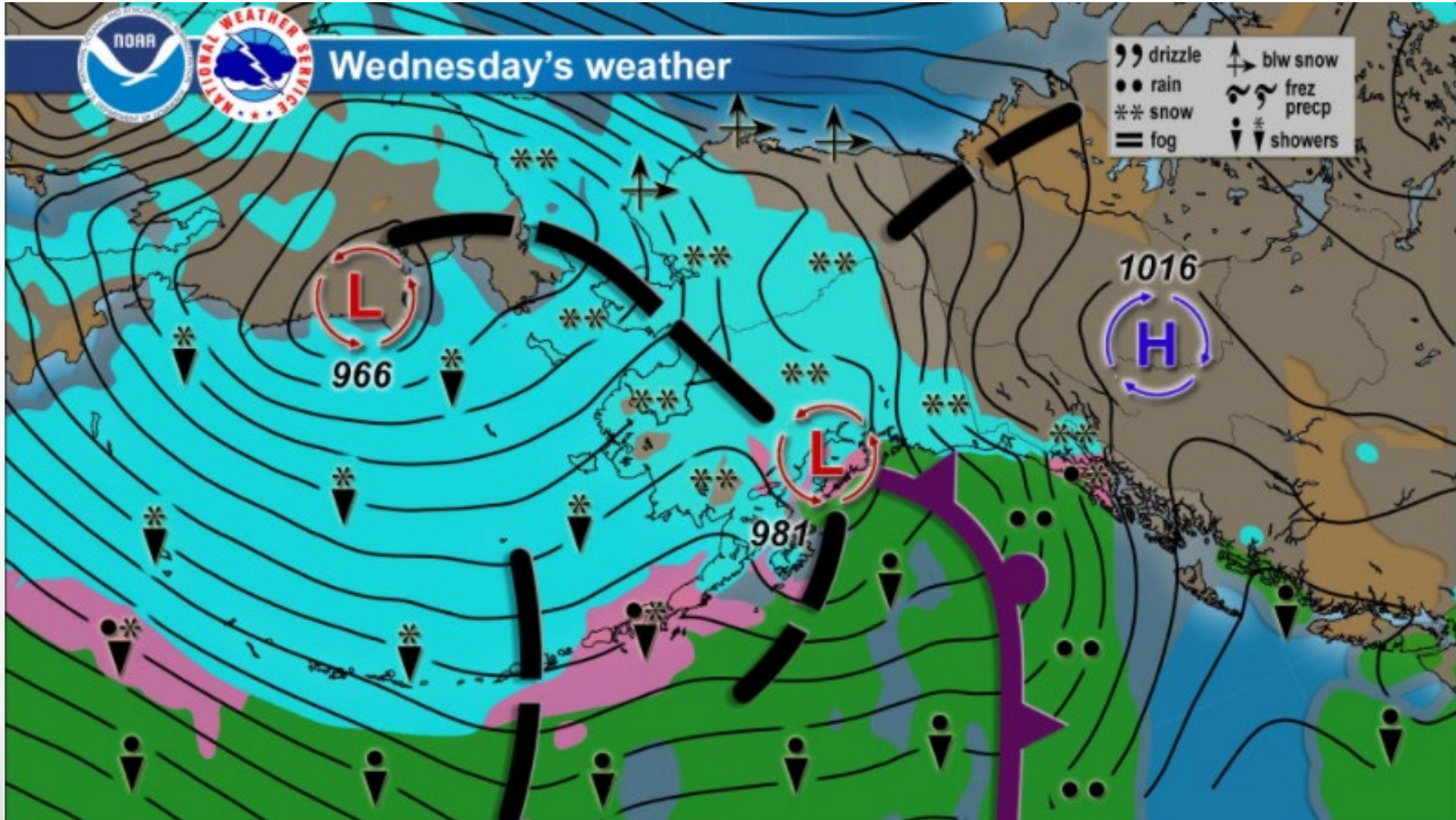
Southeast

- IFR flying Wed night and Thurs



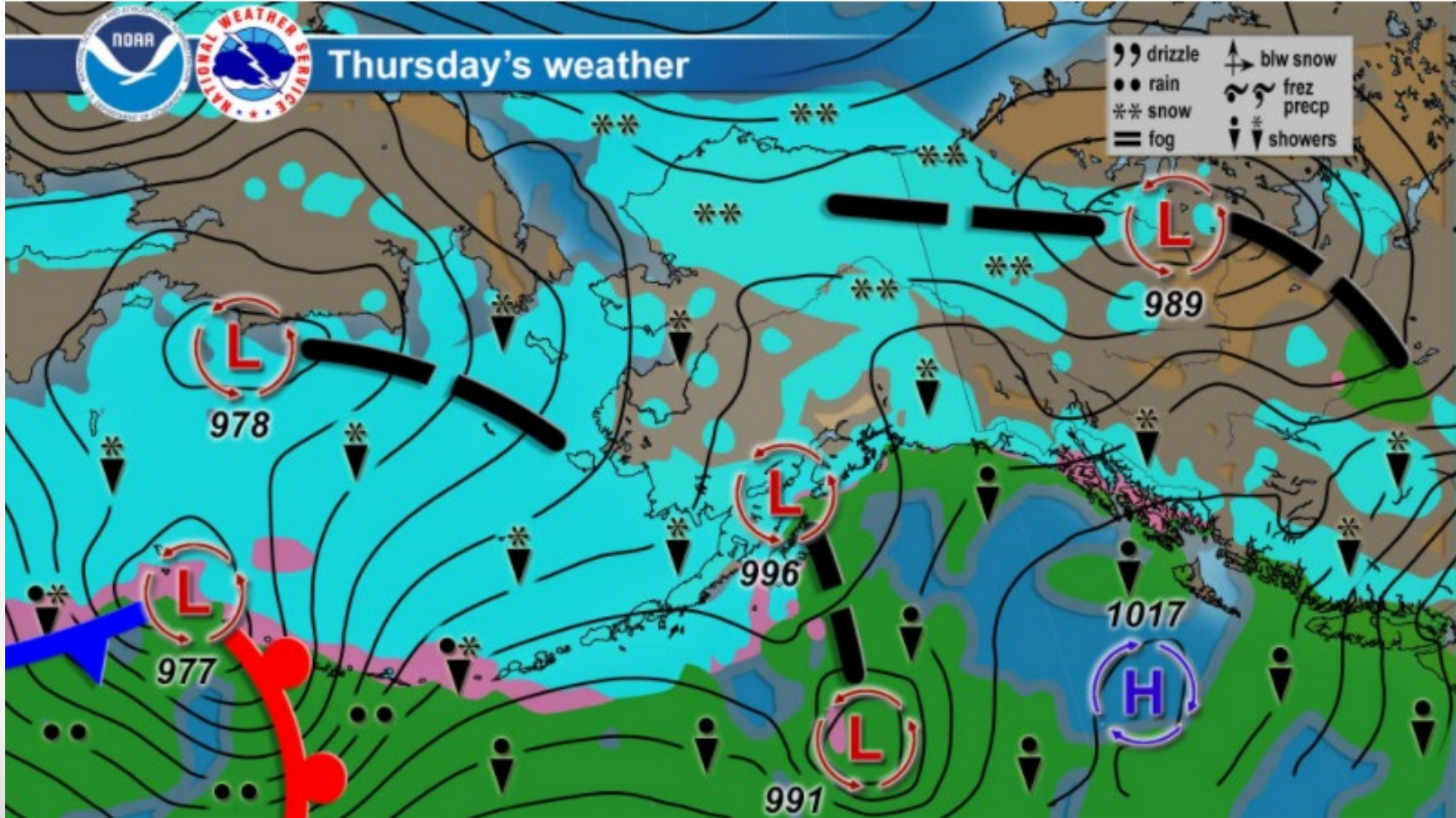


Today's Weather





Tomorrow's Weather

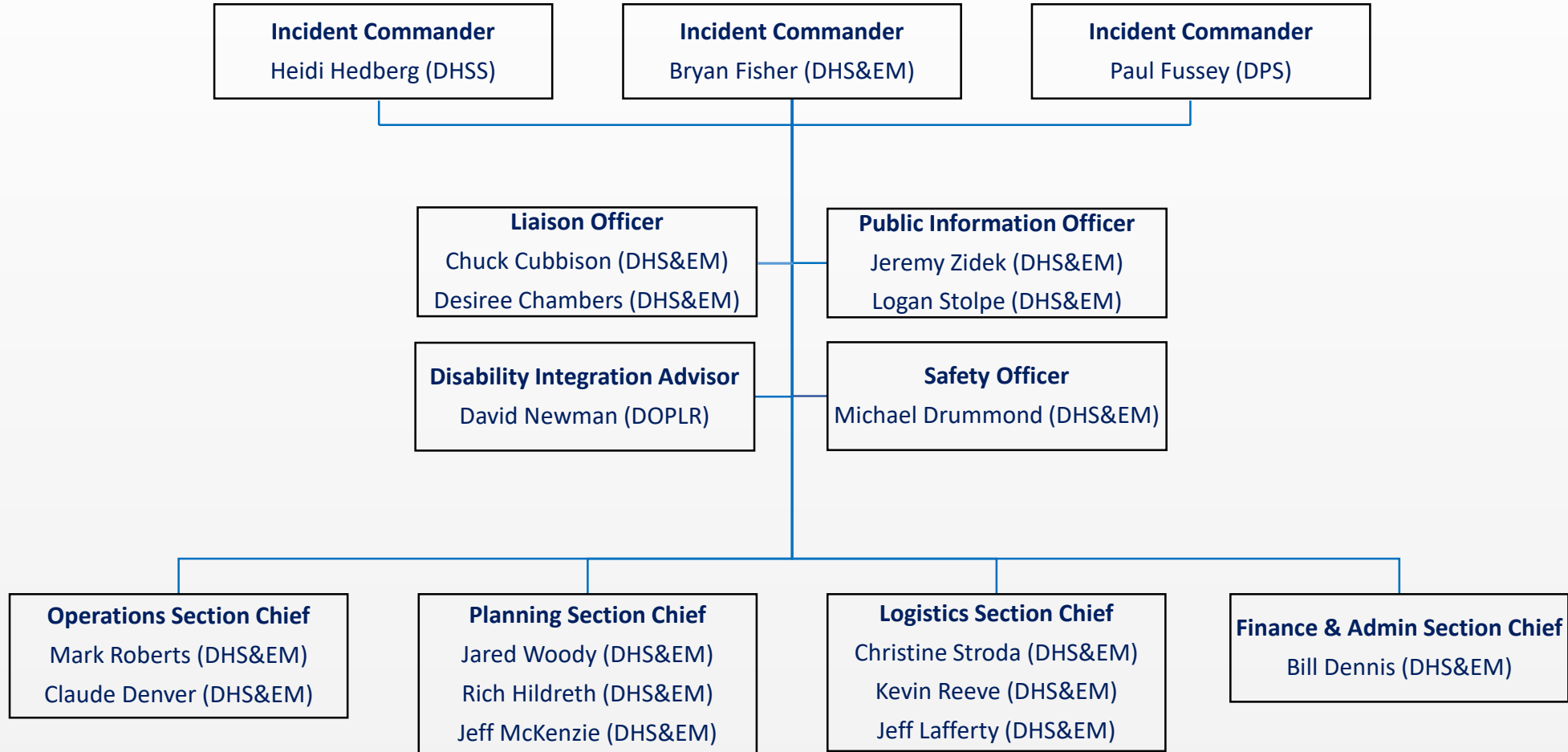

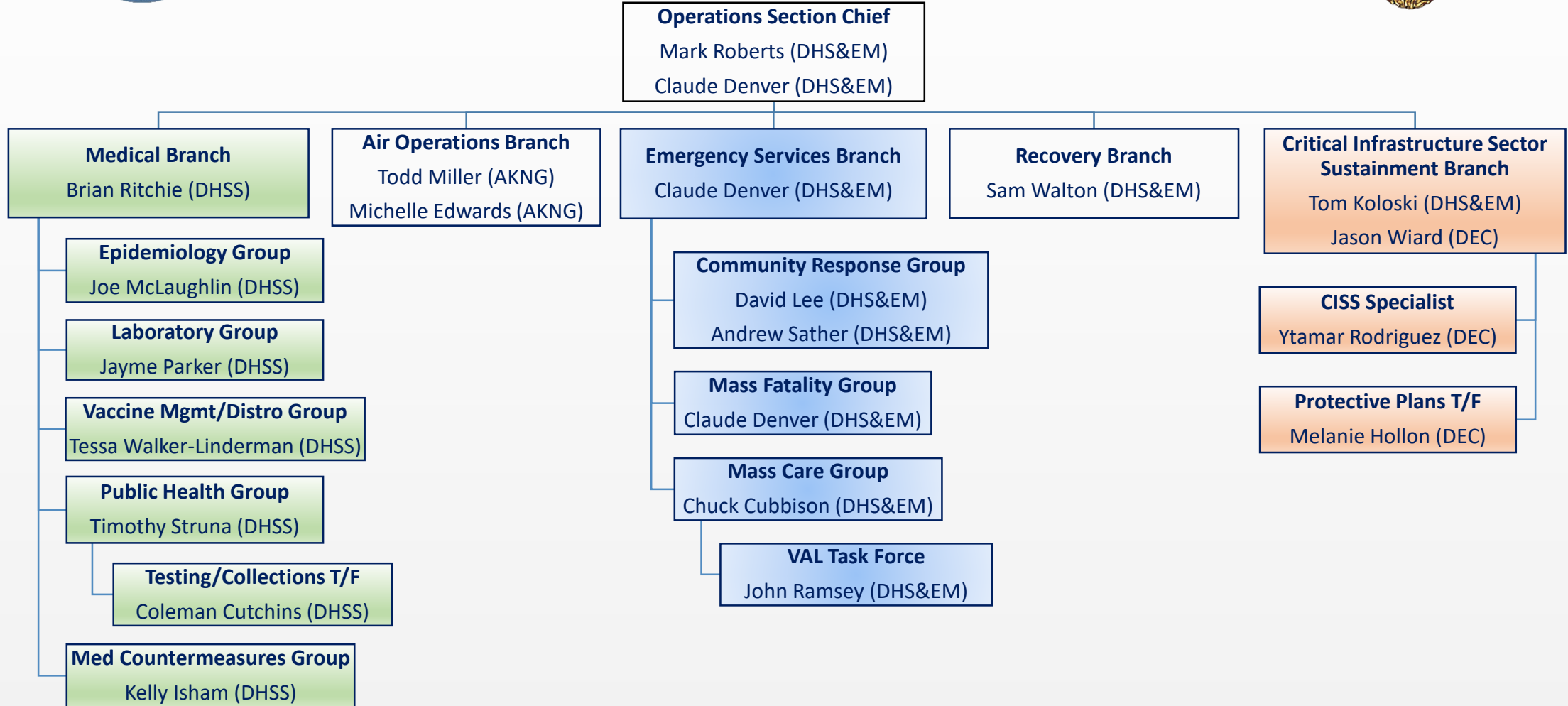
