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## State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) Activated to Level 2

### Incident Overview / Timeline of Significant Events

- 3/11 Governor Dunleavy declares a Public Health Disaster Emergency.
- 3/14 Governor Dunleavy announces the first confirmed case of COVID-19 in Alaska.
- 3/20 Governor Dunleavy announces Alaska COVID-19 Economic Stabilization Plan.
- 3/25 First out-of-state death of an Alaska resident reported in Washington.
- 3/27 First in-state death of an Alaska resident reported in Anchorage.
- 3/28 Case count in the state exceeds 100.
- 4/7 Case count in the state exceeds 200.
- 4/9 President Trump approves a major disaster declaration for Alaska.
- 4/16 Case count in the state exceeds 300.
- 5/20 Case count in the state exceeds 400.
- 6/3 Case count in the state exceeds 500.
- 7/2 Case count in the state exceeds 1000.
- 7/13 Case count in the state exceeds 1450.
- 7/20 Case count in the state exceeds 1950.
- 7/26 Case count in the state exceeds 2600.
- 8/3 Case count in the state exceeds 3300.
- 8/10 Case count in the state exceeds 3700.
- 8/17 Case count in the state exceeds 4200.
- 8/24 Case count in the state exceeds 4700.
- 8/27 SEOC reduces to Preparedness Level 2.

### Interior

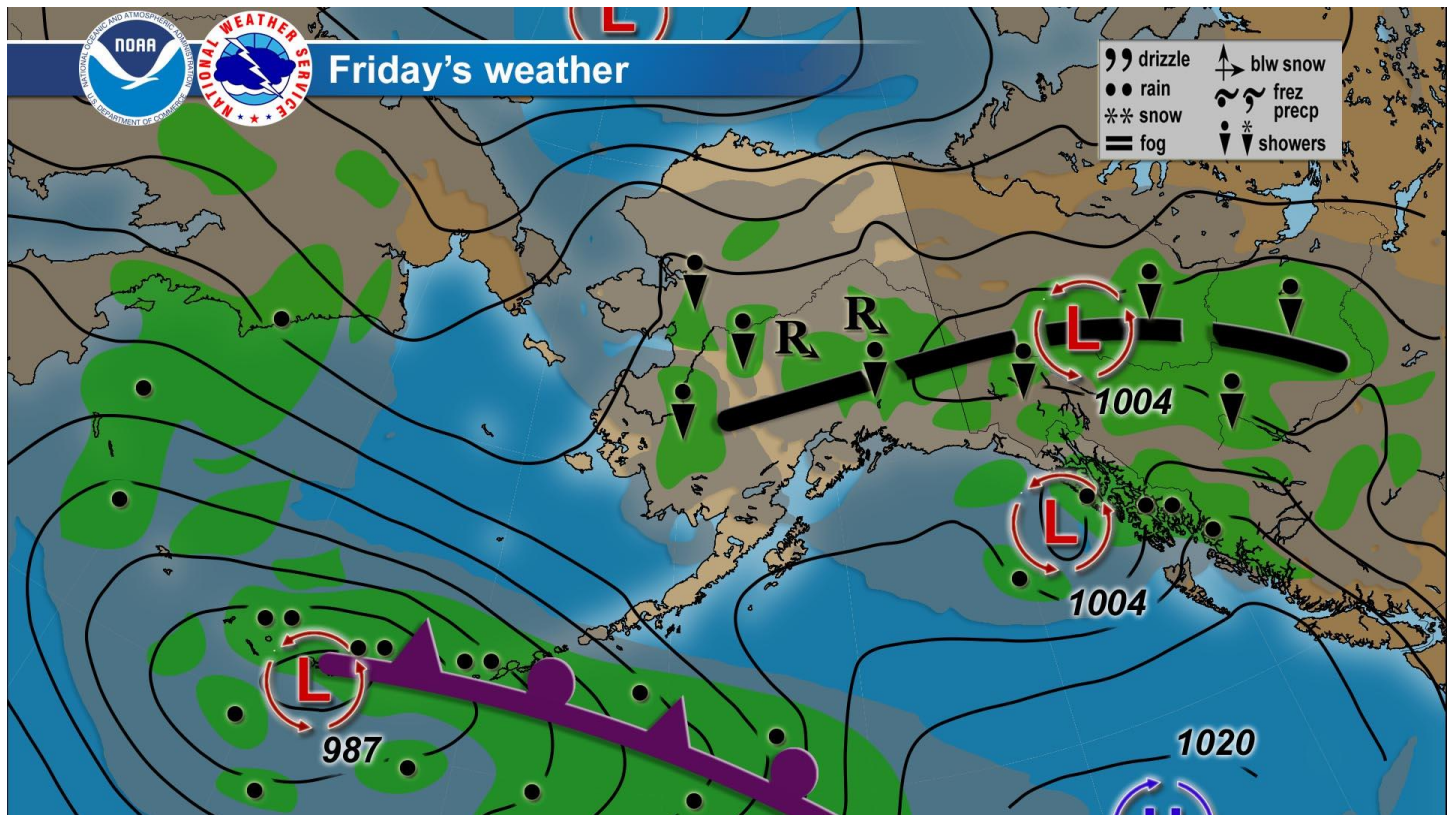
- Isolated afternoon thunderstorms, highest likelihood over western Interior
