## FEMA Disaster Assistance Team in Kenai Peninsula for Two Weeks

**ANCHORAGE, Alaska** – A FEMA disaster survivor assistance team is available for the next two weeks in Kenai Peninsula Borough to help residents who were affected by the Nov. 30 earthquake apply for disaster assistance and get advice on appealing eligibility decisions.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency team can also answer questions about the status of an applicant's registration.

Alaskans have until **Feb. 28** to apply for the Alaska Individual Assistance program online at [Ready.Alaska.gov](http://Ready.Alaska.gov) or call **855-445-7131**.
